Commenced with a moderate breeze from
W. S. W. Ship standing to the S. at sunset took
in sail at daylight made sail heading
W. S. W. at 11 AM saw the Land. at noon more
Ship to the S. E. Employed in Ship's duty
Lat by Obs 35.08. S. Long by Obs 114.14. E.

Wednesday Sept 6th

Commenced with a moderate breeze from
S. S. W. Ship heading S. E. Nothing in sight
at sunset took in sail, Middle and latter
part light hailing winds and calm. saw
Nothing. Employed in Ship's duty
Lat by Obs 35.14. S. Long by Obs 114.14. E.

Thursday Sept 7th

Commenced with light winds and Calms
Middle much the same. Latter part a fresh
at N. N. E. Ship heading N. W. sent down
the Main Topgallantmast Employed repairing
it. At noon saw a shoal of long Spinn
Whales. Sailed. No Obs.



Friday Sept 8th

Commenced with a fresh breeze at N. N. E.
the Boat in pursuit of Whales. Sailed to 2
Whales killed one held until sunset and
then cut lost 5 fangs and one fang
at sunset Calm. the Land in sight Bearing
per Compass N. by E 15 Miles at 4 P. M.
took the Whale a long ride. it had a
breeze from the South. Ship drifting
up shore. at daylight the Land in sight
25 Miles distant. a fresh breeze at S.
All hands Employed Cutting.
No Obs.

Saturday Sept 9th

Commenced with a fresh gale from N. W.
with hard squalls and showers of rain. All hands
Employed Cutting at 4 PM finished
set the Fore sail Ship heading S. S. W. Middle
part much the same. Latter part light winds
at W with a heavy swell. Ship heading S. S. W.
saw Nothing but a Breach. Employed Boiling
Lat by Obs 35.56. S. Long by Obs 118.30.

Sunday Sept 10th

Commenced with light winds at W. Nothing
in sight. Employed Boiling. Middle part
much the same. Latter part fresh gales at
N. N. W. Ship heading N. E. saw Nothing
Lat by Obs 35.56. S. Long by Obs 118.31. E.

Monday Sept 11th

Commenced with a fresh gale at N. W. Ship
heading N. N. E. Nothing in sight Employed
Boiling. Middle and latter parts fresh breezes
from N. W. to N. N. W. at daylight saw the
Land bearing per Compass N. by E 25 Miles
saw Nothing more
Lat by Obs 35.17. S. Long by Obs 118.26.

Tuesday Sept 12th

Commenced with light winds and variable
the Land in sight Employed Boiling at
sunset took in sail, Middle and latter
part light winds and Calms attended with
rain squalls. At 12 Midnight finished Boiling
saw Nothing. No Obs.
