

Wednesday Sept 21<sup>st</sup>

Commences with baffling winds. Nothing in sight. at sunset took in sail, Middle and latter part strong winds from E inclining to N. Ship standing on different tacks saw Nothing. Lat by Obs 36.01. S. Long by Chron 117.18. E

Thursday Sept 22<sup>nd</sup>

Commences with fresh gales at N. Ship under short sail heading to the E. at sunset the wind shifted to West. wore Ship to the E under storm sails. Middle and latter part strong gales with hard squalls from W to N.W. with thick rainy weather. Ship under storm sails. N.C. Obs.

Friday Sept 23<sup>rd</sup>

Commences with strong gales and hard squalls at W with rain and hail at 6 P.M. turned up 3 Beaks, the Barometer down to 29.1 tenth. Middle and latter part hard gales and squalls burden with hail and rain. at daylight the Barometer down to 29 inches. Ship under storm sails. Nothing in sight. N.C. Obs.

Saturday Sept 24<sup>th</sup>

Commences with hard gales and squalls burden at W by 3 with showers of rain. Ship heading S by W under storm sails at sunset it blowing heavy with a large sea running the Ship laboring hard. at Midnight more moderate at daylight one Ship in sight wore Ship to the N and set the Fore sail. ends with variable and squally weather.

Lat by Obs 36.40. S. Long by Chron 118.12. E

Monday Sept 25<sup>th</sup>

Commences with fresh gales and variable with squalls and showers of rain. Ship heading to the North and Eastward at sunset wore Ship and put her under storm sails. Middle and latter part baffling winds and squally weather with rain saw Nothing. Lat by glimpses of the Sun 36.01. N.C. Obs.

Tuesday Sept 26<sup>th</sup>

Commences with variable winds and squally weather with rain. Ship heading to the North at sunset took in sail and wore Ship to the South. Middle and latter part fresh gales from S.W. Ship under storm sails saw Nothing. Lat by Obs 35.35. S. Long by Chron 117.03. E

Wednesday Sept 27<sup>th</sup>

Commences with fresh gales at S.W. Middle part the same. Ship under storm sails. latter part more moderate at daylight made sail heading S by E saw Nothing. Employed in Ship's duty. Lat by Obs 34.56. S. Long by Chron 117.17. E

Thursday Sept 28<sup>th</sup>

Commences with strong winds at N.W. to N.E. Ship on the Heave tack the Land in sight at 11 past 5 P.M. hard squalls with rain. but the Ship under storm sails. Middle and latter part strong gales and squally at West with showers of rain. Ship under short sail saw Nothing. Lat by Obs 35.19. S. N.C. Obs.
