made sail heading N^W by N. saw nothing
at 11 A.M. saw the Land.

saw nothing. At Noon saw a School of Sperm
Whales got Dinner and Supper.

finer but Cutting the Whale at 4 saw Whales swimming
quick couldn't tell what they were Middle
and Patten part fine pleasant weather at 7 A.M. made
sail. steered N^W saw nothing. Employed
Boiling. Lat by Obs 34.36. Long by Chron 140.44. E

Thursday Oct 5th
Commence with a fine breeze at S^E steering
N^W and S^W saw nothing Employed Boiling
at sunset took in sail, at daylight made
sail with strong breeze at S steered N^W by N
saw nothing of any account Employed
Boiling. Lat by Obs 35.00. S. Long by Chron 141.27. E

Friday Oct 6th
Commence with fresh gales from S steering
N^W by N at 4 P.M. took in sail and luff to
heading S^E, saw nothing Employed Boiling
Middle and Patten part fresh gales from S
to S^E Ship under short sail, at 6 A.M.
finer Boiling. saw nothing
Lat by a glimpse of the Sun 35.47. S.
