 took in sail; latter part fine weather at daylight
 made sail heading N saw Black Fish Landed
 and got 3 Fish.
 Lat by obs 35.40. S Long by obs 168.00. E

Saturday January 6th
 Commences with a light breeze at 8 W. Wind
 heading N. N. W. saw Black Fish Landed
 and got one Fish at sunset took in sail
 Middle and latter part strong breeze at 8 W. and
 squally at daylight made sail nothing
 in sight steered E. Employed Boiling out
 Black Fish Lat by obs 35.35. S Long by obs 168.15. E

Sunday January 7th
 Commences with fresh gales at 8 steering S by E
 at sunset took in sail, middle part lay by
 at daylight made sail steered E by N saw
 nothing. Lat by obs 35.23. S Long by obs 170.31. E

Monday January 8th Commences with a moderate
 breeze at 8 steering S by N at sunset shortened sail
 middle part steered N. E. at daylight made sail the
 three things in sight heading per compass N. N. E
 Dist 30 Mils. steered N. E. by N and sail in sight
 Lat by obs 34.30. S Long by obs 171.28. E

Tuesday Jan 9th
 Commences with light airs and calms steering for
 the three things at 8 P.M. ordered a Boat to go on
 shore but the distance proved to far came on
 Board. Middle and latter part light airs at 8 steered
 N. E. at daylight saw the North Cap of New
 Zealand heading per compass S. E. 2.5. Mils the three
 things in sight, saw nothing more employed
 repairing the Mizen Toprail.

 fairly correct 173.29. E by obs 172.54. E

Wednesday Jan 10th

 the North Cap heading per compass S. E. 2. dist 30. mils
 finished the Mizen Toprail and bent it, Middle
 and latter part a fine breeze at 8 W. steered
 N. E. All sail set saw nothing of any account
 employed navesly.
 Lat by obs 33.24. S Long by obs 176.04. E

Thursday January 11th
 Commences with a fine breeze at 8 W. steering
 N. E. Middle part variable at daylight heavy
 squalls of rain. Latter part fresh gales at
 8 steered N. E. All 1/2 downing sail set saw
 nothing. Employed in Ships.
 Lat by obs 31.57. S Long by obs 178.47. E

Friday Jan 12th Commences with fresh
 gales at 8 steering N. E. Middle and latter part
 fresh gales at 8 to 8 W. steered N. E. saw nothing
 Employed scrubbing down Decks. Made 8.
 Lat by obs 30.19. S Long by obs 181.15. E
