drawing sail set. Middle and latter
part moderate breezes from NE to N
attended with squalls. Ship bearing NW by W

Commences with baffling winds from
NE to NW and squalls. Middle part
variable winds and squalls with heavy showers
of rain. Latter part light airs at 8 steering

Commences with a light breeze at SE & E with
light showers of rain. Employed Blacking
the Suckers and painting the brass work.
