

Sunday March 13. 11

Commences with a brisk breeze at N.E. and
overcast steering for Port Ligea at 2 P.M. & Men
came on Board from shore, returned that we
could be supplied with vegetables, at 4 p.m. &
I went on shore at 7 I returned with 7 bbls of
Sweet Potatoes and 6 bbls of Onions, ~~etc~~ settled
up and got clean at 11 P.M. steamed N.W.
at day light saw Pape's Group, bearing from
Camp Pass N.W. distant 12 Mils. at 4 P.M.
Sailed by Ltros 14.12. the Ltros 30 Mils to San Mateo
Lat 8° 45' 28.00. N. Long 80° 40' connected 14.13. 2

Monday March 14th

Commenced with a moderate breeze at
E. N. E. steering N by W. at 6 P. M. Landed and
caught a Turtle and picked up a broken
spar a bent 10 feet long with 2 iron bands
on it. Latter part light wind at E. N. E. steered
N by W. At 11 A. M. saw St. Peter, Island, bearing
per compass N by N. Dist 4 Mils. Employed
Dredging Boats.

Tuesday, March 20th

Commenced with a light breeze at 2.00 & ship
Leaving St. H. Pedro's in sight, finished painting
3 Boats. Latter part a fresh breeze at 8.00 with
thick rainy weather staid till 8.00 saw
Nothing. Employed in ships duty, went down
the Minor vessel upon V.C. B.

Wednesday March 21st

Commenced with a fresh breeze at E. by N. Ship
beating E by S with wind rising, weather
middle part variable. Letter bar + band gales and equals
harder with rain. the gale commencing at W and
bearing round to the North W. and to N. Ship
under storm sails ran E. thence.

Thursday March 22nd

Commenced with fresh gales at N. inclining to moderate.
Ship heading E. N. E. under short sail. Made
port & moderate at Midnight save Ship's head
W. W. latter part light winds at N. E. Ship
heading N. E. ~~the~~ I. H. saw the flying of
Aurora's ring, bearing per compass W. N. W. distant
30 Miles. Employed repairing the Mainmast

Friday March 23rd

Commenced with light airs and Calms Ship heading East, Tallying in sight but the Island Employed repairing the Main sail and Painting the Mast Boat, Middle part Calms and Light airs at 5 P.M. steered N E & at daylight the Island of Amoy was seen per compass W N W Dist 20 Mils at 10 point of A.M. saw the Island of Futuwa heading per compass N W & at Dist 35 Mils. saw Tallying more steered N E with a fine breeze at 5 P.M. finished the Main sail and ~~ready~~ on board the Mission Sloop. Employed repairing it. overcast weather. Nbs
