saw Cutting Employed Boiling.
Lat by Ch 39.25. N. Lon 116.41. E.

Sunday May 6th
Commences with light winds at 8 P.M. Latten on
right Middle and Latten part variable at daylight saw
one Ship at 9 P.M. saw Whales Lamen to no purpose, Employed
Boiling and starting down.
Lat by Ch 38.57. N. Lon 116.50. E.

Monday May 7th
Commences with light winds saw one Whale yawning
quick Middle and Latten part fine weather Employed
Boiling. saw one Whale Lamen to no purpose.
Lat by Ch 38.32. N.
