Thursday May 10th
Commenced with light breezes at 8 A.M. stowing
oil. Nothing in sight but Humpbacks. Employed
sawing at sunset took in sail, stowing oil.
at daylight made sail. Nothing in sight. Employed
scrappingy down. at 4 A.M. saw one Ship and one
Whale. Driven to no purpose. Lat by Ch 40.14. E.

Friday May 11th
Commenced with fresh breezes at 8. plenty of
Whales in sight. Driven to no purpose at sunset
took in sail. Middle part variable. Latter part calm
saw Whales driven and parted to a Polar Whale and drove
at 11 A.M. Captain Towner came a long side taken one
Whale seen & saw him 3 Ships in sight. Employed
raising up the keels for water. No Ch.



Saturday May 12th
Commenced with a brisk breeze at 8. saw Whales driven
parted and killed. At 6 P.M. took the Whale a long side
3 Ships in sight at 5 A.M. commenced cutting at 4 finished
made sail saw Whales. Driven to no purpose 4 Ships in
sight. No Ch.

Sunday May 13th
Commenced with fine weather saw Whales driven
to no purpose. at 3 P.M. Captain Cash came a long side
10 Whales 16.00. Driven at sunset took in sail and
Commenced Boiling 5 Ships in sight. Middle and
Latter part light winds at 8. saw nothing but
Ships and Boats chasing Whales. Employed Boiling
Lat by Ch 40.22. S. Long by Ch 134.15. E.

Monday May 14th
Commenced with a light breeze at 8. saw one
Whale. young quick. Middle and Latter part light
airs and Calms attended with thick fog saw 2 Ships
Employed Boiling. No Ch.

Tuesday May 15th
Commenced with a calm and thick fog. Employed
Boiling middle part variable. Latter part fresh
gales at 8. A.M. with thick fog Ship under moderate
sail saw 2 Ships. Employed Boiling. No Ch.

Wednesday May 16th
Commenced with fresh gales at 8. A.M. with thick
fog at 7 P.M. finished Boiling. Middle and Latter
part strong gales at 8. with thick fog and rain
Ship heaving. Extra and under short sail. Nothing
in sight. No Ch.
