Commences with light breezes at W. and pleasant steering S. by E. the land in sight and one ship at 4 P.M. had a sharp tempest, middle part hailing latter part moderate breezes at West and pleasant steering S. by E. to S. by E. one sail in sight. Employed variously. Lat by Obs 41.53. N. Long by Chron 145.27. E.

Sunday May 27th

Commences with light hailing airs. Employed huddling Boats. at sunset fresh gales at S with thick rain, weather ship heading S. All forward sail set. Middle part fresh gales at S to N.W. stand S to S. by E. latter part more moderate to strong S. by E. All drawing sail set. saw nothing.

Monday May 28th

Commences with hailing winds. Nothing in sight. Middle and latter part much the same steered S. by E. saw one ship. Employed plotting Water. Lat by Obs 42.33. N. Long by Chron 148.33. E.

Tuesday May 29th

Commences with hailing winds and overcast saw one Whale down to no purpose. Middle and latter part hailing winds and calm. saw nothing. Employed variously. putting up Pipe shafts to stent Water in. Lat by Obs 42.44. N. Long by Chron 149.56. E.

Wednesday May 30th

Commences with hailing airs and calm. Middle part the same latter part light winds at W with thick fog. Employed plotting Water. saw nothing. No obs.

Thursday May 31st

Commences with light winds at S.W. with thick fog steering S. by E. Middle part moderate breeze at S.W. and pleasant weather steered S. by E. All drawing sail set saw nothing. Employed repairing Water Casks.

Lat by Obs 43.36. N. Long by Chron 153.18. E.

Friday June 1st

Commences with a moderate breeze at S.W. Nothing in sight. Middle and latter part a fine breeze at S.W. to W. with thick fog steering S. by E. All drawing sail set saw nothing. Employed repairing Water Casks. No obs.

Saturday June 2nd

Commences with a fresh breeze at W. and thick fog. Middle and latter part strong breezes at S.W. and clear steering S. by E. one ship in sight at 9 A.M. spoke ship like last New York 600 tons. Employed variously. Lat by Obs 45.17. N. Long by Chron 158.51. E.

Sunday June 3rd

Commences with a fresh breeze at N.W. steering S. by E. All drawing sail set. Middle part much the same latter part a fresh breeze at S.W. steering N. by E. All drawing sail set saw nothing.

Lat by Obs 46.37. N. Long by Chron 160.00. E.

Monday June 4th

Commences with strong winds at S.W. and overcast. saw 3 or 4 Whales down to no purpose. Middle and latter part strong gales at W to S.W. steered S. by E. All forward sail set saw nothing. thick overcast weather with rain. No obs.
