in sight of any account. Middle part much
the same. At 2 M. finished Boiling. Latter part
moderate breeze at S.E. attended with thick misty
weather steering N.W. saw Nothing. Employed
steaming down. No oil

Saturday June 16th

Commences with light baffling winds and
misty weather. Employed steaming down
Nothing in sight. Middle and latter part baffling
air and calm saw Nothing at 8 A.M. finished steaming
oil. Got by Ch 56.17. Landed by Ch 173.40. E

Sunday June 17th

Commences with light winds at N. and account
Ship heading S.W. Middle and latter part baffling
winds saw Nothing
Got by Ch 56.55. L. No oil

Monday June 18th

Commences with baffling air and E. wind. Middle
and latter part a fine breeze at S.W. steamed N.W. E
All day long sail set saw Nothing. Employed
scrapping down
Got by Ch 57.24. L. Landed by Ch 177.28. E



Tuesday June 19th

Commences with a moderate breeze at S.W. steering
N.W. E. All day long sail set at 3 P.M. saw 2 or
3 Whales. Landed and killed at 4 P.M. took
the whale a lumpy side at the conference. Cutting
At 1 M. finished cutting. Latter part fresh breeze at S.W.
steering N.W. E. at 7 M. saw one whale going quick.
didn't follow. at 12 part 11 M. saw 2 Whales. Landed
and danted to no purpose. Employed Boiling
No oil. thick overcast inclining to fog

Wednesday June 20th

Commences with a brisk breeze at S.W. and
foggy steering N.W. E. Middle and latter part the
same. saw Nothing. Employed Boiling
No oil. Got by a count 61.00 oil

Thursday June 21st

All the day hours a fine breeze at S.W. attended
with thick overcast weather with fog squalls
steamed N.W. E. saw Nothing. Employed Boiling
in steaming down oil. No oil

Friday June 22nd

Commences with a fine breeze at S.W. with
thick overcast weather steering N.W. E. Nothing
in sight. Employed Boiling and steaming down
oil. Middle and latter part fresh breeze at S.W.
attended with thick fog squalls at 7 A.M. saw from
10 to 20 or 30 Whales. Landed for Landed to no purpose. the
weather not fit to whale. at 9 M. finished Boiling
Employed Boiling out to stow oil. Ship leaving
by a mummy the Whales

Got by Ch 62.00 L. Landed by Ch 177.28. E
