Monday June 25th
 Commences with fresh gales at SSW with
 fog squalls, and Ship in sight at 2 P.M. spoke
 Ship Junior Linckham New Bedford 450. tons
 Middle part the same. Latter part more moderate
 with rain and fog squalls, saw Whales the weather
 not fit to whale. No obs

 Tuesday June 26th
 Commences with squally winds with rain
 and fog squalls, saw Whales. Toward noon saw a Red
 Whale run for it, it proved to be a good Whale
 at 2 P.M. took the Whale along side and commenced
 cutting. At 1 P.M. finished cutting lost the Head
 at 4 P.M. the Junior Elued down, Latter part light
 airs at S. and Calm. Employed Bailing saw a
 plenty of Whales. Lat by Obs 61.33. N. No obs

 Wednesday June 27th
 Commences with light airs and Calm with a plenty
 of Whales in sight. at 1 P.M. Capt Linckham came on
 Board. at 4 P.M. hauled for a Whale fastened & killed and
 at 8 P.M. took to the Ship. Middle and latter part light
 winds at S attended with fog squalls and rain. Employed
 Bailing and clearing out the Blubber room
 No obs

Thursday June 28th
 Commences with a fresh breeze at SE with rain
 squalls. At 1 P.M. commenced cutting the Whale at 11
 P.M. finished, Latter part strong breeze at SE and on at
 some squalls. Employed Bailing and caulkering and
 hoisting out to stow oil. No obs

Friday June 29th
 Commences with a fresh breeze at E. Nothing in
 sight. Employed Bailing and stowing oil. Middle and
 latter part fresh breezes and variable rain. Nothing. Employed
 Bailing and stowing down oil.
 Lat by Obs 62.01. Long by Chron 182.57. E

Saturday June 30th
 Commences with a moderate breeze at WSW
 Nothing in sight. Employed Bailing and stowing
 oil. Middle and latter part light baffling winds and
 Calm attended with fog saw Nothing. Employed
 Bailing and mending up Shakes No obs

Sunday July 1st
 Commences with light airs and Calm with thick
 fog. Employed Bailing and stowing oil. Middle
 part a breeze at E shifted S.W. at 11 P.M. saw Whales
 chased by the wind standing on apparent tack
 Latter part fresh breezes at SE with thick fog
 Ship lay by at noon finished Bailing Employed stowing
 down oil No obs
