



Monday July 2nd

Tuesday July 3rd

Commences with a fresh gale at North Ship laying by a Whale. Employed stowing down oil. Middle part more moderate at 3 A.M. commenced cutting at 7 A.M. it blowing on to a fresh gale broke one tangle. Ware Ship and cut to leeward, one Ship in sight. No Ch.

Wednesday July 4th

Commences with a fresh gale at N. All hands Employed cutting the Whale at 2 P.M. Capt. Tinkham came down and spoke us got 2 W. saw 8 saw him at 7 P.M. finished cutting middle and latter part more moderate. Employed Boiling Nothing in sight but the Junior.

Thursday July 5th

Commences with a fresh breeze at N. Employed Boiling and raising up Shakes. Middle part the same. Latter part a light breeze at N.W. All hands Employed variously Boiling breaking out raising up Shakes. 8⁰⁰ saw the Junior Clew down.

Left by Ch. 61, 11. Perry & Chas. 18, 1, 2, 4. 8.

Friday July 6th

Commences with a light breeze at N.W. Whales in sight and plenty of mark to do, Middle and Latter part the same. Boiling and stowing down oil. the Junior close to us. No Ch.

Saturday July 7th

Commences with light airs and Calms saw Whales several to no purpose. Employed Boiling and stowing down oil. 8 A.M. finished Boiling. Latter part a moderate breeze at N. saw Whales coming quick to the North. Didn't power. Employed stowing oil.

Left by Ch. 61, 24. A. No Ch.

Sunday July 8th

Commences with a moderate breeze at N. with fog equals saw Whales several to no purpose. Middle part thick fog. Latter part light winds at N. Nothing in sight but the Junior. Employed stowing oil.

Monday July 9th

Commences with light airs at North Nothing in sight. Employed stowing oil at 7 P.M. finished. Middle and Latter part light winds at N. Nothing in sight. Employed raising up Shakes. No Ch.



Tuesday July 10th

Commences with a moderate breeze at N.E. saw one or two Whales several fastened and killed at 10 P.M. took the Whale a long ride at 3 A.M. commenced cutting at 8 finished. Latter part light squalls at N. with fog equals saw several several Whales the same as saw got. Didn't power. Employed Boiling.
