sight. All Boiling or cutting. Ship at anchor

Saturday July 28th

Commences with a calm and thick fog. Employed
cutting the Whales. at 5 P.M. finished. Middle and
latter part strong winds at N. with thick weather.
Employed Boiling. Ship at anchor

Sunday July 29th

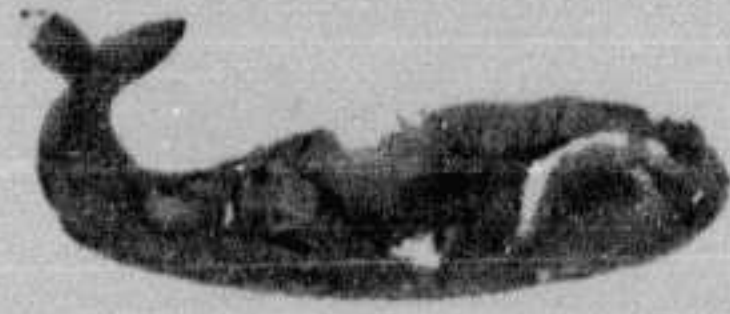
Commences with strong breezes at north thick
weather at 6 A.M. spoke Ship Metcom.
Shack of New Bedford 15.00. Middle and latter
part moderate. Employed Boiling and Coopering
Meet saw several Whales to far up to lower
5 Ships in sight

Monday July 30th

Commences with light winds at N. Ship at
anchor middle and latter part strong breezes
at N.W. with fog squalls saw several Whales
young of year. Downed to repair. Employed
Boiling and storing down oil

Tuesday July 31st

Commences with strong breezes at N.W. with fog.
Employed Boiling and storing down oil middle
and latter part much the same at 2 P.M. finished
Boiling. Ship at anchor



Wednesday August 1st

Commences with light winds at N. Employed Boiling
saw many Whales. Lower part and killed 2 Whales &
killed from the Ship. got the Whale a long ride at 2 P.M.
at 4 P.M. commenced cutting. Ship at anchor

Thursday August 2nd

Commences with a moderate breeze at S. inclining to
thick fog. Employed cutting the Whales at 5 P.M. finished
saw a plenty of Whales. Middle and latter part fresh breezes
at S. with thick fog. Employed Boiling and storing down
oil. saw nothing. Ship at anchor

Friday August 3rd

Commences with a fresh gale at S. with thick fog
Ship lazily to anchor. Employed Boiling and storing
down oil. Middle and latter part fresh gales
at S. with thick fog and rain and a heavy sea
at midnight found the Ship to be dragging
bent the Lashoon Chain and let of the anchor
put stoppers on to the Chain. Employed storing
oil. cutting in sight

Saturday August 4th

Commences with fresh gales at S. with thick fog
and rain. Employed Boiling and raising up Hooks
Middle part the same latter part moderate with
thick fog and rain. Employed Boiling and Coopering
oil. with anchors & head

Sunday August 5th

Commences with light air and a heavy swell with
thick fog. Employed Boiling and storing oil, at
5 P.M. finished Boiling. Middle part thick fog and rain
latter part light winds at N. with fog squalls. Employed
Coopering oil and clearing the Lashoon anchor
