

Monday Sept 10th

Commences with light breezes at 8 AM. Ship heading S by E. Middle and latter part baffling winds attended with calms and rain squalls. Ship working to the S. Nothing in sight at 11 AM. Jugging the ship near the Land. None ship to the north ends with thick fog and strong winds at 3. No Ob.

Tuesday Sept 11th

Commences with strong breezes at 8 with thick fog and rain. Ship heading N N E. All proudant sail set. Middle part 1 baffling. Latter part strong gales at 8 AM to 11 AM with rain squalls and thick weather. Ship standing on opposite tacks saw Nothing.

Wednesday Sept 12th

Commences with fresh gales at 8 AM. Nothing in sight. Ship standing on opposite tacks. Middle and latter part fresh gales at 11 with squalls and showers of rain. saw Nothing off the Land.

Lat by Ob 53.03. N. Long by Chron 172.14. W

Thursday Sept 13th

Commences with fresh gales at 11 with rain squalls. Ship standing on opposite tacks saw Nothing. Middle part the same. Latter part light winds at 8 AM with overcast weather. at 7 AM saw the Fox Islands it being thick and hazy. Could not tell much about them. Ship making the best of her way between the Islands to the Southward.

Friday Sept 14th

Commences with light baffling winds at 8 AM. Some of the Fox Islands in sight. Ship making thren between the Islands with baffling winds and strong tide ripes. Middle part strong breezes and squally. Ship standing on opposite tacks. Latter part strong gales at 8 AM with thick rain squalls at 7 AM saw one Island bearing for Compass S N E. Which I judge 5 Miles distant. Ship heading S E. Carrying all proudant sail. it bearing on to land gales and squalls harder took in sail as caution require. No Ob.

Saturday Sept 15th

Commences with hard gales at 8 AM and squalls harder. Ship under reef. Topsails and Cones all possible sail that a Ship can carry. At 11 AM the Mainmast handed the Mizen. At 3 PM hauled the Mainmast at 4 hauled the Fore Topmast. the Ship laboring hard and making a good deal of Water. I judge the Land 25 Miles distant under the Ship's lee. Middle part more moderate at 4 PM the wind veered to the Westward. Steered S E. and made all proudant sail. Latter part fresh breezes at 11 steering S E by E. saw Nothing. Sailed rarely. Lat by Ob 50.57. N. Long by Chron 169.14. E.

Sunday Sept 16th

Commences with fresh breezes at 11 steering S E by E. All sail set. Nothing in sight. Middle part the same. Latter part moderate breeze at 8 AM and overcast steered S E by E. All sail set.
