

Tuesday January 29th
Commences with light hailing winds from S to N.W. At 1 P.M. saw the Western part of the Falkland Islands Middle part fresh breezes at S.W. and squally with rain. Ship standing on opposite tacks, Latter part fresh gales from W. steered N.W. at daylight saw the Island. Lat by Obs 54.31 S Long by Obs 62.08

Wednesday January 30th
Commences with strong gales from W to S.W. steering N.W. carrying all pendant sail at 6 P.M. past a Reef under short sail, Middle and Latter part gales and squalls harder at S.W. steering N by W. carrying all pendant sail saw nothing. Lat by Obs 48.14 S Long by Obs 61.46.

Thursday January 31st
Commences with strong gales at S.W. steering N by W. Middle and Latter parts brisk breezes from S.W. to W. saw nothing. Lat by Obs 46.15 S Long by Obs 61.10. W

Friday February 1st
Commences with a fine breeze at S.W. steering N by W. saw one Ship, Middle and Latter part much the same. Employed braking out Oil between decks Capering and stowing down. Lat by Obs 44.34 S Long by Obs 60.10

Saturday February 2nd
Commences with light winds at N.W. Ship heading N.W. Middle and Latter part hailing winds Employed braking out Oil Capering and stowing down saw nothing. Lat by Obs 43.12 S Long by Obs 59.14. W

Sunday February 3rd
Commences with hailing airs and Calms Middle much the same. Latter part moderate breeze from N. saw nothing. Lat by Obs 42.34 S Long by Obs 58.28 W

Monday February 4th
Commences with a fresh breeze at N.W. Ship heading N.E. Middle and Latter parts much the same saw 2 Ships. Lat by Obs 41.26 S No long

Tuesday February 5th
Commences fresh breezes at N.W. Ship heading N.E. At 2 P.M. saw a School of Spinn Whales. Several and fastened to 2 Whales drawn from ones and the others took the Lines at sunset gave up the Whales. Middle part all sorts of Weather from 1 to 3 o'clock Sharp lightning attended with heavy peals of Thunder, and 55 minutes of the time it blowing a cumulated Typhoon and the rain falling in Torrents. All hands employed securing sails steered the Ship before it under 3 main sails Latter part Calm. saw nothing. Lat by Obs 41.03 S Long by Obs 55.45 W
