Lat by Obs 34.07. Long by Chron 43.20. W

Thursday February 14<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with light breezes at 8<sup>th</sup> Ship  
heading N. E. Middle and latter part much the  
same. At 12 past 10 A. M. saw a Sperm Whale  
leeward partway killed and 1 At 12 Noon  
took the Whale a long side.
