Commences with a fine breeze at N.W. steering
N.W. by N. Middle part variable
winds and weather rare. Mottling Employed
Painting. Lat by Ch 31.10 N Long by Ch 69.10 W

Saturday April 6th

Commences with fresh breezes at S.W.
At 4 P.M. had a tempest attended with
a hard squall and the rain falling in torrent
call all hands and shorten sail. At 8 P.M.
Ship under a close reef. Main Topmast middle
part struck lightning with heavy thunder
attended with hard squalls and the rain
descending in torrents. Latter part fresh gales
from S.W. to W.S.W. at daylight made all pendant
sail steering N.W. by N. saw nothing Employed
scrubbing the lower masts

Sunday April 7th

Commences with fresh gales at N.W. with
hard squalls and heavy showers of rain
steering N.W. by N. at 7 P.M. the wind shifted
in a squall to N.E. shortened sail and

battering winds. Latter part fresh gales at N.W.
Ship heading W. saw 1 Ship

Monday April 8th

Commences with fresh gales at N.W. Ship heading
W. by S. Middle part baffling airs and Calms. Latter
part light airs at S and overcast steered N.W.
one sail in sight. Employed Painting Ship

Tuesday April 9th

Commences with a moderate breeze at S. and
overcast weather. Employed Painting at 5 P.M.
had a hard squall with a heavy shower of
rain as usual to wash the paint off middle
part baffling winds. Latter part fresh gales
from N.W. to N. several sail in sight
Employed murely

Wednesday April 10th

Commences with light breezes at N.W.
Ship heading W. Middle part light airs and Calms.
Latter part fresh gales from S.W. to S.W. steering
N.W. by W. carrying all pendant sail & sail in

Thursday April 11th

Commences with strong gales from S.W. to W.
attended with a tempest and a heavy fall of
rain. Middle part baffling winds and variable
Latter part fresh gales from N.E. with thick
rainy weather. Ship heading N.W. All
pendant sail set saw one sail

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
