found the Ship in the Stream at 10th the

from 1st till 6th light winds at 11th Middle
part falling winds from N to N.W. at 6th 11th
the temperature of the Water 73rd at 7th at 7th at 4th at 10th 60
fetter fresh breeze at 11th Ship heading N.W.
several sail in sight Employed & Darning
Lat by Ob 36.45 N Long 73.52 W

Saturday April 13th

Commences with light breeze from N.W.
Ship heading N.W. Middle part fresh
winds at 8 Ship heading N.W. Latter
part falling winds and weather saw several
sails Employed variously have the Dog Harks
are Ready Lat by Ob 38.11 N Long 73.19 W

Sunday April 14th

Commences with all sorts of weather
at times fine pleasant weather with a
moderate breeze at 11 steering N.W.
all sail set, and at other times hard squalls
from W to N.W. took in sail and made
sail a canvas required Middle and
Latter part hard gales from W.N.W. and
squalls harder Ship heading N.W. to N
under a two reef Main Top sail and Fore sail
No Ob Lat by account 49.25 Long 72.30 W

Monday April 15th

Commences with hard gales from W.N.W. to N.W.
and squalls harder Ship heading N to N.W. Middle
part the same Latter part more moderate at
day light made all prudent sail heading
N.W. at 10th saw Black Island bearing
N Dist 18 Miles saw several sail Employed
variously Lat by Ob 40.45 N Long 71.44 W

Tuesday April 16th (1850)

Commences with fresh gales from W.N.W.
to N.W. Ship heading N and N.W. at sunset
Black Island bearing W by N Dist 15 Miles
shorten sail
