This day begins with light winds from ~~W. S. W.~~
 Snow squalls and plenty of drift ice in sight
 Employed in fitting whirling gear Middle part
 The same latter part Strong breeze under all sail
 On the wind on the Starbuck tack
 Lat 64 48 Long 51 45

Saturday June 11th

This day begins with strong breeze from E.S.E. and
 Thick foggy weather full the topsails and double
 Reef the topsails middle and latter part clear
 Weather wind E.S.E. under all sail on the
 Starbuck tack
 Lat 64 54 Long 56 14
