Saturday Sept 3rd

This day begins with moderate gales from N by W cloudy weather
 Sited Tigge Island at 1 P.M. 8 miles distant middle part
 Moderating & little sited Chukle Island at 12 P.M. 15 miles
 Distance latter part thick weather spoke the Brig Isabel
 Wind light bearing S.E. by compass

Sunday Sept 4th

This day begins with fresh breezes from N by W and
 thick fog employed in breaking out low line Middle
 Part much the same snow squalls at 7 a.m. sited
 North Bluff 10 Dist. latter part much the same
 Saw several Icebergs spoke the Brig Isabel wind
 Moderating strong S by E

Monday Sept 5th

this day begins with light winds from N by W
 fine weather running along sarge island several
 Icebergs in sight mid part wind howled to
 N. O by A fresh Breezes sited Resolution island
 Dist 20 miles later part wind S. W clear
 weather spoke the Brig Isabel she is bound
 home

Tuesday Sept 6th

this day Begins with fresh Breezes from N thick
 fog mid part fog Lift up Saw some icebergs
 employed in coiling series later part strong
 Breezes from N. W clear weather 20 miles from
 Resolution bearing N

Wednesday Sept 7th

this day begins with fresh Breezes from N by E
 fine weather Laying Aback of Hall island at
 daylight Braced forward Beating to the Windward
 mid part Baffling winds several icebergs in sight
 later part a calm lowered down one Boat and
 leaving the Ship came to anchor at 8 pm in 22
 fathoms of water in Newgmoke saw two whales
 But Did not Lower for them it was nearly Dark

1864

Thursday Sept 8th

this day Begins with light winds and calms at 3 a.m.
 Heighed Anchor stood on the wind and the captain
 went to sound out a harbour funnel to much
 water mid part Baffling winds saw one
 whale lowered for him But Did not strike
 the Captain sounded out another harbour
 came to Anchor at 2 p.m. in 23 fathoms of
 water later part light winds and calms

Friday Sept 9th

this day Begins with strong Breezes from N
 snow squalls lowered down the boats for whaling
 saw one Whale off shore But Did not strike mid
 part much the same later part wind
 moderating two boats went Ashore got two
 casks of water

Saturday Sept 10th

this day begins with light winds N. W and
 clear weather saw one whale off shore But
 Did not strike mid part light winds and
 calms fine weather later part much the
 same saw plenty of ice berges wind N. W
 and clear weather

Sunday Sept 11th

this day begins with strong Breezes from
 N. W and clear weather lowered down the
 Boats for whaling Beginning to get cold ice
 making ashore mid part much the same
 later part moderate Breezes saw no whales
 so ends this day

Monday Sept 12

this day begins with strong breezes from N. W. and
 clear weather toward the boat for whaling saw one
 whale Middle part much the same later part
 light winds several Icebergs in sight so ends this day
