Tuesday Sept 13th

This day begins with strong breezes from N.W. and fine weather employed in breaking out the mizen block for dried apples and Mollasses and rye middle part moderating a little toward the boats for whaling. Saw no whales. Latter part light winds and calms.

Wednesday Sept 14

This day begins with fresh breezes from S.W. and fine weather toward boat for whaling. Saw no whales. Middle part much the same. Latter part winds baffling and calms fine weather so ends this day.

Thursday Sept 15

This day begins with light winds from S.W. and thick fog toward boats for whaling. Saw no whales. Middle part began to rain. Boats came aboard. Latter part much the same wind N.E. and light foggy.

Friday Sept 16

This day begins with light baffling winds rainy and thick fog. Shot one seal. Middle part much the same. Latter part calm and thick fog. Employed in washing two boats.

Saturday Sept 17

This day begins with light winds N.E. and thick fog. Employed in washing two boats. Got six cask of water from shore. Stowed them down main hatch. Middle part much the same toward the boats for whaling. Saw nothing. Fog lit up. Latter part calm and thick fog.

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Monday Sept 19

This day Begins with light winds from S.W. very cold in making on sea. Mid part much the same fog cleared away a little and set in thick again. Latter part foggy. Weather mild light from W. & N. ^{24th} Tuesday 20th

This day Begins with strong breezes from E. & E. and thick

Foggy weather employed in breaking out water. Saw one barrel of Pork and part much the same. Latter part foggy lit up and set in thick again. Wind breezing in stronger so ends this day.

Wednesday Sept 21st

This day Begins with strong breezes from S. S. W. thick foggy weather and raining. Made off decks and put much the same water. Part wind shifted to S. E. and thick foggy. Weather light winds so ends this day.

Thursday Sept 22nd

This day begins with strong breezes from S by W. and thick foggy weather employed in washing off decks. Mid part much the same. Went ashore and got one cask of water and stowed it down the main hatch. Latter part wind light foggy lit up took two turns. Cast on the chain.
