Saturday, Oct 8th

This day Begins with light winds from S & W
And fine weather lowered the Boats for whaling
Saw no whales mid part calm Boats returned
To the ship and commenced breaking out for
hailes rigging a Boat for the natives later
Part calms and snowing, set down the topgallant
Sunday, Oct 9th

This day Begins with light winds from S & W
And thick fog employed in breaking out lumber
For to repair the house on Blacklead island broke
Cut coal and filled stoves with water and fire
Strong breezes and snowing, set part fresh Gales
From S & W ends this day

Monday, 10th

This day Begins with fresh breezes from S & W
Thick fog employed in breaking out lumber
Schooner Leda came in the harbor with one
Whale about noon a merman harbor and
Felling, it about on the Pioneer of Nindanah
Later part moderating broke out vinegar and
Sugar and Pork

Tuesday, Oct 11th

This day Begins with fine weather calms and
Cloudy lowered the Boats for whaling saw no whales
Going very quick mid part stormy Boats returned
Coiling lines for the natives Boats went to
Blacklead Island with lumber to repair the
House later part snowing Wind N & W
Schooner Leda got under way for Amurao
Harbor so ends this Day

1864

Wednesday, Oct 12th

This day Begins with calms and light winds the
Boats went whaling saw one whale going very quick
Boats returned took two casks of coal and two casks
Of Bread down to Blacklead Island and repairing
The house later part light winds and fine weather
The Brig clarea went to the shelter

Thursday, Oct 13th

This day Begins with light winds from N & W
And fine weather lowered the Boats for whaling
Four whales did not show any chance to strike
Mid part much the same working on the house
Later part light breezes from the N & W and clear
Weather employed in rigging another Boat for the
natives

Friday, Oct 14th

This day begins light winds from N & W and
fine weather lowered the Boats for whaling saw four whales
did not show any chance to strike mid part much
the same working on the house later part light
breezes from the N & W and clear weather employed in
rigging Boats for the natives

Friday, Oct 14th

This day begins with light winds from N & W and fine weather
very cold ice making on the shore lowered the Boats for
whaling saw no whales mid part the same getting casks
and wood ready for the Island later part calm and
light winds broke out. Unlashed Pork and Beef

Saturday, Oct 15th

This day begins with light winds from N & W and clear weather
lowered the Boats for whaling saw two whales did not strike
mid part much the same saw several whales setting
up casks for the Island later part calm and light winds
weather very cold
