

1864 this day begins

Sunday Oct 16th

this day begins with light winds and calm fine weather covered the Boats for whaling saw two whales going very quick to the northward wind part much the same later part calm and warm Cloudy weather

Monday Oct 17th

this day begins with light Winds and calm fine weather lowered the Boats for Whaling saw no Whales Boats returned broke out the Fore hatch for Sheeps setting up Pipes for the Island mid part much the same later part calm and Snowing very warm so ends this day

Tuesday Oct 18th

this day begins with light winds and calm fine weather cleared lowered the Boats for Whaling saw a number of Whales but did not strike Whales going very quick mid part much the same Broke out Meadasses and Flou setting up Pipes later part calm and fine

Wednesday Oct 19th

this day begins with calm and fresh Breezes from N.W. and thick Snow storm lowered the Boats for Whaling saw no whales mid part much the same Boats returned went down to the Island with a raft of pipes and one cask of wood and a stove for the house later part Storm cleared away and calm broke out a Barrel of Pork

Thursday Oct 20th

this day begins with light winds from S.W. and Snowing covered the Boats for Whaling saw one Whale mid part strong Breezes from N.W. Boats returned took five turns out of the Cable and broke out a cask of water later part strong Breezes and Snowing very cold and Breezing setting up pipes for Black-head Island

Friday Oct 21th

this day begins with fresh Breezes from S.W. clear weather and very cold ice making very fast to the shore lowered the Boats for whaling saw seven Whales off shore mid part light winds from W by S rose the cutting falls and setting up cranks for the Island later part light air and Snowing very fast

Saturday Oct 22th

this day begins with light B'ling winds and calm clear weather lowered the Boats for Whaling saw no Whales mid part light winds from S.E. and Snow Squalls and calm Boats returned to the Ship broke out Meadasses and a Barrel of pork broke out six Barrels of Pork for Black-head Island and one Barrel of flour later part calm and Snowing Broke out one Cask of Water

Sunday Oct 23th

this day begins with light winds from S.W. and fine weather lowered the Boats for whaling saw nothing set in thick and Snowing mid part Boats returned wind hauled to S.E. and Snowing fast employed in cleaning Snow off the Decks & Boats later part wind N.W. very strong and thick weather

Monday Oct 24th

this day begins fresh breezes from S.W. and clear weather very cold lowered the Boats for whaling saw whales off shore but did not strike mid part baffling winds and calm later part light winds from N.W. and very cold
