Tuesday Oct 26th

This day begins with light winds from S.W. and fine weather. Lowered the Boats for whaling. Saw whales off shore. Mid part two Boats returned to the Ship and got a safe of water. Later part calm and warm. Stowed down Boats. This day begins.

Wednesday Oct 26th

This day begins with fresh Breezes from S.W. and thick weather. Mid part snowing very fast and hugging in the Schooner. S.B. Hawk of New London came to anchor from American Harbor got nothing. Broke out water and three slop casks later part much the same.

Thursday Oct 27th

This day begins with fine Breeze from N.E. and thick snow storm. A native Boat swamped. A stern of as and lost was and Boat part mid part. Wind hauled to S.E. and blowing strong. In clearing snow off the Deck breaking out one cask of molasses meal and Pork. Later part wind moderated snowing a little.

Friday Oct 28th

This day begins with fine Breezes from N.E. and fine weather. Lowered the Boats for whaling. Saw whales. Did not strike the schooner. S.B. Hawk went to the Netherland mid part the Big Pioneer struck a whale and got him. The schooner Leander came from American harbor got nothing. Stacked on and lost. Mine Broke out one cask of Ruad and coiling one. Tub of tallow. Later part light winds and clear weather.

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Saturday Oct 29th

This day begins with fine Breezes from N.E. and fine weather. Lowered the Boats for whaling. Saw whales. The mid Boat struck a whale. Did not strike. Got fast mid part much the same. Later part light winds and calm. The Big Clara came to anchor from the Netherland got nothing. The schooner Leander in a cruise. Broke out one cask of water and Flour.

Sunday Oct 30th

This day begins with light winds from N.E. and fine weather. Lowered the Boats for whaling. The Starboard Boat struck and landed from him. Mid part fresh Breeze from N.E. and cloudy. Later part light winds from N.E. and clear. Saw the schooner S.B. Hawk going. Bear hand. Broke out one Barrel of molasses for the Island. Corn and a Barrel of Pork is end this day.

Monday Oct 31st

This day begins with light winds from N.E. and fine weather. Lowered the Boats for whaling. The Starboard Boat struck and landed him on the side on Blackhead Island and anchored him. Saw whales in Bear sound mid and last part light winds and calm.

Tuesday Nov 1st

This day begins with light winds from N.E. and fine weather. Lowered the Boats for whaling. Saw whales off shore. The Big Boat struck and lost him. Mid part calm and fine weather. Towed the whale to the ship. Later part calm weather.
