Wednesday, Nov 2nd

This day, Begins with light wind and calm toward
The Boats for whaling, saw several whales the Bow Boat
Struck and lost the line the next Boat went on a
Whale and the Boat over next him broke him and
sent him forward and took another man in his
Place mid part began looking at 2 pm got him
Cut in at 10 pm later part calm and clear weather
And none for this night time of year

Friday, Nov 4th ~~Thursday, Nov 3rd~~

This day, Begins with light winds from S.W. and
Clear weather lowered down the Boats for whaling, saw
Plenty of ~~off~~ ~~shore~~ whales off shore next Boat struck
Iron pointed and lost him saw the Schooner S.B.
Haines off shore whaling, mid part calm and light
Winds employed in trying out later part
Much the same

Thursday, Nov 3rd

This day, Begins with light winds from S.W. and
Fine weather lowered the Boats for whaling, native
Boat struck Boat swamped and lost the whale
In sound mid part calm and water Brig Pioneer
Got a whale off shore later part much the same
Started the by works broke out water

Saturday, Nov 5th

This day, Begins with fine breeze from S.E. and
Clear weather lowered the Boats for whaling, saw
nothing, Breezing on stronger mid part Boats
Returned employed in breaking out for casks for
Oil trying out and storing down oil later part
Fresh Gale and snow storm

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Sunday, Nov 6th

This day, Begins with fine Gale from S.E. and
Thick weather employed in trying out and
Storing down breaking out in the Brig Pioneer got
Another whale mid part moderating, snowing fast
later part calm and snowing

Monday, Nov 7th

This day, Begins with fresh Gale from N.W.
and thick weather got the cable clear breaking
out Broad and getting it in pipes throwing
down Water and oil casks and Bow Whisk
Part much the same the Schooner S.B.
Haines came to anchor and got under way
again in Bow Boat and got three Whales later
part fresh Breeze broke out Barley and a barrel
of Pork

Tuesday, Nov 8th

This day, Begins with fresh Breeze from N.W.
and clear weather lowered down the Boats
for whaling   Bow Struck Puns
drawed and lost him mid part much
the same saw plenty of Whales later part
Light winds and fine weather very cold
Took out hams and Beef took several samples
in the charge to star a boat in the place
Antonie Rodichey's and send in the
forecaster
