Friday Dec 16th

This day begins with light winds from N.E. and fine clear weather the mate and seven men went to Blackhead for some lumber mid part calm quite cold employed in drawing ice from shore Capt. Allen went on board Schooner Seaside latter part much the same broke out a barrel of pork

Saturday Dec 17th

This day begins with fresh gales from S.E. and thick snow storm some load of ice from shore mid part much the same Capt. Allen and Morgan come on board latter part fresh breezes from S.E. clear weather broke out incl. 111

Sunday Dec 18th

^{Mercury below} This day begins with light winds from N.E. and clear weather ^{Mercury below} Capt. Morgan went on board of his vessel mid part wind hauling light S.E. and setting in thick latter part very thick and snowing 10°

Monday Dec 19th

^{Mercury below} This day begins with strong breezes from S.E. and fine weather ^{Mercury below} employed in hauling ice for steps along side of the ship middle light part moderating and good weather latter part light winds 1° but cold firing the ship water half a mile from the ship

Tuesday Dec 20th

^{Mercury below} This day begins with light winds from S.W. and clear ^{Mercury below} fine weather employed in building four steps along side 15° In the gang way middle part much the same latter part calm and beautiful clear weather

Wednesday Dec 21st

^{Mercury below} This day begins with light wind from N.E. fine clear weather ^{Mercury below} got two loads of ice from shore mid part much the same light to water in sight from the ship latter part light air from 14° N.E. and very clear weather to ends this day

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Thursday Dec 22nd

^{Mercury below} This day begins with fresh breezes from N.E. and thick ^{Mercury below} 14° weather toward dawn the boat and turned them over on the latter part moderating water one mile from the ship latter part much the same broke out Molasses and a Barrel of pork to ends this day

Friday Dec 23rd

^{Mercury below} This day begins with light winds from S.E. and thick ^{Mercury below} 2° snow storm employed in clearing snow off decks middle part much the same Capt. Morgan and Davidson come on board very warm latter part light air and snowing very fast

Saturday Dec 24th

^{Mercury below} This day begins with light air from S.W. and thick ^{Mercury below} 4° weather middle part fresh breezes from S.E. and snowing 1° Very fast cleared out the house for a dance the natives and the Brig crew came on board latter part light winds snowing to ends this day

Sunday Dec 25th

^{Mercury below} This day begins with light wind from N.E. fine weather ^{Mercury below} 3° Very warm middle part much the same latter part light 4° light air and growing cold no water in sight

Monday Dec 26th

^{Mercury below} This day begins with light air from S.W. clear weather ^{Mercury below} 8° employed in getting two loads of ice from ashore 11° the natives went to sealing got nothing to much snow on the ice middle part wind haul to N.E. and growing cold latter part calm the mate went over to the Schooner Seaside this day
