Mercury below Wednesday March 8th
 Morning 15° This day begins with light winds from S.W. clear weather
 Night 10° Broke out a load of bread mid part light wind
 Morning 10° Thick weather snowing a little hauled one
 load of ice from ashore one boat Steer and the Cooper
 went in Brig Pioneer and returned the south and mouth
 of the river. The Brig boat then went to Black
 Lead Island latter part much the same Capt Spicer
 returned came up from the Hook Duck down the
 Gulf with a team load of bread

Thursday March 9th
Mercury below This day begins with light air and calm clear weather
 Morning 8° Broke out a cask of Molasses and hams the third mate
 Night 10° Went off on a hunt and has not returned mid part
 Strong breeze from N.W. coming in thick latter part
 moderating clearing the natives got two Seal to day

Mercury below Friday March 10th
 Morning 26° This day begins with light winds from N.W. clear
 Night 14° Weather broke out from Capt Morgan left hear for
 Black Lead Island Capt Spicer and Kenner left
 Hear with a team of coal going to their vessels across
 the Gulf mid part calm and cloudy two boat
 Steers came hear from the Schooner and left hear again
 latter part much the same water looks to be closer
 then it was So ends this day

Mercury above Saturday March 11th
 Morning 6° This day begins with Fresh Gales from S.E.
 Night 11° And thick snow storm mid and latter part
 much the same

Mercury below Sunday March 12th
 Morning 8° This day begins with light breeze from S.W. clear weather
 Night 9° Broke out a barrel of oil to burn and Molasses
 mid part breezing up strong latter part much
 the same all kept one family of our natives
 has come back Cooper of the Pioneer came on board

Mercury below Monday March 13th
 Morning 19° This day begins with light winds from S.W. clear weather
 Night 14° Broke out load of ice from ashore mid and latter part
 breezing up fast Capt Allen went to the Brig Pioneer
 and returned

Mercury below Tuesday March 14th
 Morning 16° This day begins with light winds from S.W. clear
 Night 12° Weather broken went over to Black Lead Island with a
 sled to move a native family over here to the ship
 mid part breezing up and coming in thick
 latter part much the same

Mercury below Wednesday March 15th
 Morning 22° This day begins with a strong breeze from N.W.
 Night 18° This weather our natives is moving over into
 Bear Sound to catch young Seal mid part strong
 stronger and thick weather latter part the same

Mercury below Thursday March 16th
 Morning 19° This day begins with light winds from S.W. clear
 Night 9° Thick weather the cooper of the Pioneer went to the
 Brig mid and latter part calm and clear weather
 Capt Allen went over to doctor one of the Schooner
 Leader Natives De ends this day

Mercury below Friday March 17th
 Morning 17° This day begins with calm clear weather hauled
 Night 14° One load of ice from ashore mid part much the
 same latter part very thick and commencing to
 snow broke out Molasses for the Stead and Chatterin
 the natives got one Seal

Mercury Saturday March 18th
 Morning 20° This day begins with strong gales from S.E. with thick
 Night 6° Snow weather snowing a little mid part much the same
 latter part wind shifted to S.W. and moderating

Mercury above Sunday March 19th
 Morning 10° This day begins with strong winds from S.W. with thick
 Noon 26° Snow storm mid part more moderate snowing as before
 Night 11° Latter part light wind and clear weather
