Monday March 20th

Morning 14° This day begins with calm clear weather employed
 Noon 31° In clearing ice and snow from on top of house and
 Night 12° Inside broke out thick coal mid part much the
 same except a little snow falling latter part thick
 Snow Storm and strong winds in puffs from S.E.
 The natives got one Seal Seals this day

Tuesday March 21st

Morning 26° This day begins with light winds from S.E. cloudy
 Night 28° Weather dug out some cash from under the Snow
 And put them on top of the Snow Carpenter employed
 In making a small shed finish it to day mid
 Part weather much the same latter part calm and
 thick weather Seals this day

Wednesday March 22nd

Morning 28° This day begins with calm clear weather employed in
 Night 15° Digging out the boats and putting them on top of
 the Snow Carpenter sawing out bone to shoe a sled
 Mid part much the same hauled one load of ice
 from ashore latter part thick fog the natives got
 three seal very warm to day two of our natives come
 up from Bear Sound

Thursday March 23rd

Morning 24° This day begins with light air and calm clear
 Night 14° Weather employed in breaking out in between decks
 And scraping frost off from over head carried the
 Center out on the ice so the sun would stick on
 it to show it out broke out mollusks for the men
 Mid and latter part much the same
 Seals this day

Friday March 24th

Morning 13° This day begins with light air and calm clear weather
 Night 17° Baked out Meal and cranberries Carpenter employed
 In making a small shed for the mate Mid and latter
 Part weather much the same natives got one seal

Saturday March 25th

Morning 22° This day begins with light air and calm cloudy weather
 Night 30° Carpenter employed in repairing an old sled broke
 out from sled part the same sent up and
 crossed the fore and main top gallant yards
 Latter part weather much the same

Sunday March 26th

Morning 15° This day begins with calm and thick clouds
 Night 24° Weather Snow falling fast Mid and latter part
 much the same Seals this day

Monday March 27th

Morning 19° This day begins with light winds from N.W. with clear
 Night 15° Weather employed in hauling one load of ice from ashore
 The native women is employed in clearing the ships
 Seal skins Mid part calm Sealed of to long sleds
 Laid the ice close to the ship found it to be two
 feet thick Latter part much the same

Tuesday March 28th

Morning 13° This day begins with light winds from S.W. with a thick
 Night 16° Snow Storm Broke out a cash of Seal Mid part
 (the ship broke through the ice) weather the same Latter part light winds from S.W. with
 and came up about one foot thick cloudy and the light morning Seals this day

Wednesday March 29th

Morning 1° This day begins with light winds from S.W. clear
 Night 14° Weather employed in stopping the banking around the ship
 Down and cutting the rudder clear of the ice mid part
 hauled one load of ice from ashore
 Latter part thick cloudy weather the natives got one seal
