Morning 2^o This day begins with light winds from S.W. calm weather
 Night 11^o Employed in carrying a Box of Bread over to Black Lead
 Island the weather is very bad Mid part weather much
 The same one of our natives come up from Bear Sound
 and report they have got three young Seal they are very scarce
 Latter part fresh gales from S.W. clear weather water is about
 12 miles off

Friday March 31st

Morning 11^o This day begins with fresh gales from S.W. clear
 Night 11^o Weather employed in finding out how much
 Provision we have got on board Mid part weather
 Much the same broke out in rainberries Latter
 Part more moderate and thick weather

Saturday April 1st

Morning 11^o This day begins with fresh breezes from S.W.
 Night 6^o With thick cloudy weather crew employed in
 hauling a Box of Bread on a sled over to
 Black Lead Island Mid part weather much
 The same hauled one load of ice from shore
 Latter part strong winds cloudy weather
 The natives got one young Seal

Sunday April 2nd

Morning 11^o This day begins with strong winds from S.W.
 Night 11^o Thick weather Brought a cask of Pork Mid part
 More moderate snow falling a little Latter part
 Light winds snow falling fast

Monday April 3rd

Morning 8^o This day begins with calm clear weather crew employed
 Night 1^o In hauling two pipes of Bread to Black Lead Island
 Mid part snow falling a little coming in thick
 one of our natives come from down the Gulf and
 Report they have got 16 young Seal Latter part the same

Tuesday April 4th

Morning 1^o This day begins with calm cloudy weather crew
 Night 1^o Employed in hauling one cask of flour and a pipe
 of Bread over to Black Lead Island Mid part
 Breezing up from N.W. and blowing rather
 fast blowing strong thick weather

Wednesday April 5th

Morning 6^o This day begins with strong winds from N.W. cloudy
 Night 8^o Weather Mid and latter part much the same

Thursday April 6th

Morning 11^o This day begins with light winds from N.W.
 Night 4^o Clear weather Capt Allen with three men went over to
 the Schooner Leader after a Box of tea the rest of the crew
 Employed in hauling one cask of coal and a pipe
 of bread over to Black Lead Island Mid part weather
 Much the same hauled one load of ice Latter part
 the same

Friday April 7th

Morning 2^o This day begins with strong gales from S.W. with
 Night 11^o Thick weather Capt Morgan and Neesby came
 on board Mid and latter part weather the same

Mercury Above

Saturday April 8th

Morning 6^o This day begins with fresh breezes from the westward
 Night 1^o Thick weather broke out from Port and Beane mid part
 strong gales thick cloudy weather Latter part the same
 Capt Morgan and Neesby left here to day

Sunday April 9th

Morning 2^o This day begins with light winds from S.W. clear
 Night 11^o Cloudy weather Capt Davidson came on board broke out
 the same Mid and latter part much the same
 a few natives come on board from Black Lead
