Monday April 21st
Morning 15th This day begins with light wind and calm and cloudy
Night 16th Weather calm employed in hauling one load of ice Bricks
The fore and main topgallant sails and lowered the
Fore and main topgallant to day Mid part calm sent
Down the fore to sails mended it and bent it again
Weather part weather much the same the natives got 8 red

Tuesday April 22nd
Morning 20th This day begins with light air and calm
Night 21st Clear weather Carpenter employed in mending 4 boats
Mid part much the same crew employed in
Sledging wood from the ship to Ashore Leather part
Weather the same

Wednesday April 23rd
Morning 21st This day begins with calm clear weather
Night 22nd Mid and Leather part much the same

Thursday April 24th
Morning 22nd This day begins with light wind and calm
Night 23rd Crew employed in storing the ground tier in the fore
Hull and run 29 barrels down shore out of the tank
Mid part weather much the same Beck out the after
Hull everything clear clean it out ready to stow the
Ground tier Carpenter employed in making 4 sleds
Leather part much the same haul down
The house what we find at when we went in winter

Friday April 25th
Morning 23rd This day begins with calm clear weather employed in
Night 24th Stowing cask down in the fore and Mizzen held
Employed 4 sled cask 400 cask flag cask for one
Hauled the cask to stow carpenter finishing 4 sleds
Mid and Leather part weather much the same

Saturday April 26th
Morning 24th This day begins with calm weather employed in
Night 25th Clearing out in between deck put all of our bone
Cask on the ice to show cooper getting up large cask
Mid part much the same crew employed in co
Scrapping the sail house leather part much the same

Sunday April 27th
Morning 25th This day begins with calm cloudy weather
Night 26th Haul 700 barrels of pipes shanks and one
Cask of boards and hoops to Black Lead Island
Mid part fresh breezes from S.W. crew employed
In Scrapping some Boat Shovel castings for
Whaling Boat and other much the same
The natives got 8 red so end this day

Monday April 28th
Morning 26th This day begins with calm weather employed in
Night 27th Scraping and washing some carpenter filling
The same finish clearing cask in the cover hold
Mid part Leather part weather much the same
Leather part washing done so end this day

Tuesday April 29th
Morning 27th This day begins with calm cloudy weather crew
Night 28th Employed in hauling six loads of cask to Black
Lead Island to day mid part calm and
Snowing very fast Leather part stop snowing
Calm cloudy weather the natives got 8 red

Wednesday April 30th
Morning 28th This day begins with thick snow storm Mid part
Night 29th Cleared up spread out our bone to dry Leather part
Came on board Leather part 7 other the same
Hauled our bone in and piled it up on deck
