

Sunday y^e 29th Remained Rough weather
all hands were still Employed a-boring
and Securing our Casks of oyl

Monday y^e 30th the weather Moderated
We finished boring and Stowing away
our oyl which was upwards of forty Barrels

Tuesday y^e 31st Remained pleasant weather
We made our Course S. W. for we suppose
the whales have left the ground and gone
to the Southward. Lat^y by obsⁿ 37-51

Wednesday y^e 1st February 1786
Good weather; we still
Made our Course to the Southward and were
Employed Fixing our boats and Vessel and
Coopering the Casks

Thursday y^e 2nd was Cloudy and foggy
the greater part of the Day we saw some
Humpbacks towards Night put out our
Boats and struck one but Night coming
on, we was obliged to Cut from her

Friday y^e 3rd was fair weather and a
fresh gale of wind at S. S. E. we made
our Course E. by S. we struck several
Porpoises this Day and saved them

Saturday y^e 4th Pleasant weather the
Wind N. we made our Course Southward
Endavouring if possible to overtake the
Right whale which have left these
Coasts and gone that way as we suppose
Spec^y Lat^y by obsⁿ 39-50

our C has not been absent from the Ship
more than one or two Days since we parted

February 1786

Sunday y^e 5th Fair weather and a brisk
gale of wind at N. N. W. we made our Course
S. W. and by obsⁿ was in Lat^y 40-12

Monday y^e 6th was more moderate and
Hazy weather; we still made our Course
S. W. and were by obsⁿ in Lat^y 41-19

Tuesday y^e 7th Remained Moderate weather
the wind westerly; we conclude to go no far-
ther to the Southward consequently at four
o'clock P.M. we wore off and stood to the
Eastward. Lat^y by obsⁿ 41-39

Wednesday y^e 8th was Rough weather
squally and Raining the greater part of
the Day the wind N. E.

Thursday y^e 9th Remained Rough weather
the wind N. N. W. we made our Course
E. N. E. the preceding Night we lost
the Ship that has parted with us since the
28th of January

Friday y^e 10th was more Moderate though
a brisk gale of wind at N. N. E. we made
our Course N. in hopes of getting on to the
ground being in Lat^y by obsⁿ 41-52

Saturday y^e 11th Remained Moderate weather
the wind N. N. W. we made our Course N. E.
and were in Lat^y 40-38

Sunday y^e 12th the weather still Remained
Moderate and a small Breeze of wind at N. N. E.
We run E. N. E. till 10 o'clock A.M. then put
about and stood W. N. W.
