

April 1786

Tuesday y^e 4th Moderate weather, but what little wind there was, being at N. we could make no better course than E. with the variation being in Lat^d by obsⁿ 24-23

Wednesday y^e 5th Remained pleasant weather And a Moderate Breeze of wind at N. we still made our course Eastward and by obsⁿ in Lat^d 24-26

Thursday y^e 6th Still Remained very pleasant weather and Moderate gales of wind at N. E. The preceding Night we put about and stood N. W. thro' Light 24 hours, Lat^d by obsⁿ 24-13

Friday y^e 7th Moderate gales of wind and variable, with Light Squalls of Rain from the N. and W. Lat^d by obsⁿ 23-64

Saturday y^e 8th Still Remained Squally and Rainy, weather the wind at N. very Contrary to us at this time being the same way we want to make our course and we suppose for that we have a Southern Current here, for though we have beat as near the wind as possible by our observation we find ourselves only in Lat^d 23-56

Sunday y^e 9th proved very Stormy weather With hard gales of wind and variable, with Thunder and Lightning and abundance of Rain. No obsⁿ this Day

Monday y^e 10th it cleared away and was good weather the wind westwardly we made our course to the Southward as much as possible our Lat^d by obsⁿ was 23-10

April 1786

Tuesday y^e 11th pleasant weather and Light gales of wind at S. E. we made our course N. and by obsⁿ were in Lat^d 22-20

Wednesday y^e 12th Remained tolerable good weather except some Light Squalls from the Eastward the wind varied from N. E. to S. E. we made our course N. E. By obsⁿ in Lat^d 21-11

Thursday y^e 13th was pleasant weather and Light gales of wind at N. E. we made our course N. N. W. Lat^d by obsⁿ 20-35

Friday y^e 14th Remained pleasant weather and Light gales of wind, the greater part of the time at N. E. we made our course N. N. W. Lat^d by obsⁿ 19-36

Saturday y^e 15th Still Remained pleasant weather and Light gales of wind at N. E. by E we kept the same course as above mentioned and were by obsⁿ in Lat^d 18-39

Sunday y^e 16th was attended with small wind and pleasant weather the greater part of the Day we still made our course to the Southward and were by obsⁿ in Lat^d 17-41

Monday y^e 17th pleasant weather and Calm the greater part of the Day we lowered down our Boat and scraped our vessel this Day, and having a small Breeze the preceding Night we made 34 miles Difference of Lat^d Being in 17-7
