

May 1786

Thursday y^e 11th was good weather Still-
and a tolerable good Breeze of wind at
E. S. E. which is farther to the Southward
than what is common here in these Trades.
We made our Course w. N. W. lat. in 12-30
About five o'clock P. M. Made the Island
of Barbadoes and it bore N. from us
We Lay off all Night and Concluded to go
In the next morning in order to get some
fresh Supplies.

Friday 12th Tolerable good weather and
a fresh Breeze of wind at E. S. E. we
Run into the Harbour at Bridgetown, but
They Refused to Let us go on Shoar or to
Trade in the Left with the Inhabitance
of the Island, Consequently we put off
for the Island of Martinico

Lat. by obs 13-12

Saturday y^e 13th was attended with Moderate
Gales and fair weather, about Nine o'clock
P. M. Made the Island of St. Lucia and it
Bore w. S. W. from us, we kept a N. W. Course
And at Ten o'clock A. M. Made Martinico
Which bore N. N. W. of us about Six or Seven
Leagues from us Lat. by obs 14-07

We Came up with the Land just at Sun set
A Little to the windward of Portugal Bay
and about Seven Leagues from St. Peters at
Which place we proposed to come to anchor

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Sunday y^e 14th about four o'clock A. M. Came
up with St. Peters and Early in the Morning beat
into the Harbour and got Leave to anchor under
the Comadores Stern; pleasant weather and very hot
We went on Shoar in order to take a walk on the
Land, not having any opportunity before since
We Left the Cape de Verde Islands which was about
the Middle of October

Monday y^e 15th Still Lay at anchor, and made it
our Chief Business to get a Market for our oyl

Tuesday y^e 16th about Twelve o'clock have up
our anchor and hall'd into the Town and
Moored our Vessel at eight went aboard of Cap. Martin

Wednesday y^e 17th Sold a small part of our oyl
all hands Employ'd a ~~hauling~~ hoisting up oyl
and keeping it and getting it in order to Raffle
ashoar

Thursday y^e 18th and Friday y^e 19th all hands were
Employ'd a hoisting up oyl and keeping it and
Raffling it ashoar Took in a Quantity of Rum
also

Saturday y^e 20th Sold a small part more of our oyl for
Cash

Sunday y^e 21st Monday y^e 22nd Tuesday y^e 23rd
Wednesday y^e 24th Still Lay in the harbor

Thursday y^e 25th in the afternoon
Made Sail and stood off for St. Eustatius

Friday y^e 26th we Lay off Guadalupe almost
Becalmed the greater part of the Day
