Tuesday May 22^d

Commenced with pleasant trades. Employed repairing
sails and painting. Latter part fine saw nothing
Lat 4-14 Long 83-35

Wednesday May 23^d

Pleasant trades. Sat 2 P.M. saw a Sulphur
Bottom whale. at 4 sent up the Fore Mast
yard. at 9 P.M. took the sick man aft. His fever
still rages. at 6 Shortened sail. course to S.W.
Latter part fine. Saw Brackles. Employed repairing
sail.

Thursday May 24th

Pleasant trades. Employed repairing sails.
at 4 P.M. sent an old main top sail. course
to. Latter part fine. Lat 4-06 Long 97-52

Friday May 25th

Pleasant trades. Course to S.W. at 6 P.M. Shortened
sail. Latter part fine. Saw nothing. at 1 P.M.
It luffed too on the off shore ground.

Saturday May 26th

Pleasant trades. at 6 P.M. Shortened sail.
Latter part fine. Saw nothing. Lat 4-20 Long 101-30

Sunday May 27th

First part pleasant trades. Saw one Chin
Back at 6 P.M. Shortened sail. Latter part
fine. Saw nothing.

Monday May 28th

First part fresh trades. Storing by the wind. Saw
nothing. at 6 P.M. Shortened sail. Latter part fine
Saw a whale ship.

Thursday May 31st

First part fresh trades. Saw Porpoises and one
sail at 6 P.M. Shortened sail. Latter part strong
trades. at 9 P.M. spoke the Doctor
Lat 4-53 Long 103-03

Friday June 1st 1855

Strong trades. Sat 4 P.M. spoke the B.B. Cummy
of Chertmouth 7 months 80 bbb. at 6 P.M. Double
Reefed the top sails and furled the main sail.
Latter part pleasant trades. Course to S.W.

Saturday June 2^d

Pleasant trades. Course to S.W. at 6 P.M.
luffed too to the wind and Shortened sail. Latter
part light trades. Storing to the westward. Saw nothing
Sunday June 3^d Long 104-09

Saturday June 3^d

Light trades. Sail Porpoises and got one. at 6
P.M. Shortened sail. Latter part fresh trades. Storing
to. Saw a piece of fat man. Lat 4-39

Monday June 4th

First part fresh trades. Course to S.W. at 6 P.M.
luffed too and Shortened sail. I wish that I
was at home with my wife. I feel that she at
this time wants the sympathy and society of one
that no earthly being can offer. but all things are in
the hands of God. Latter part fine. Saw Porpoises
and some squid.
