First part pleasant trades. Steering to S.W. at 5 P.M. raised a sail. at 6 luffed too and shortened sail. Latter part fine. Steering S.W. Lat 5-44 Long 108-50

Thursday June 7th

First part pleasant trades. Steering S.W. at 6 P.M. luffed too and shortened sail. Latter part fine. Steering S.W.

Friday June 8th

First part pleasant trades. Steering S.W. at 6 P.M. luffed too and shortened sail. Latter part fresh trades. Steering S.W. Employed Boiling over some lean oil to burn.

Saturday June 9th

First part fresh trades and squalls. Steering S.W. at 3 P.M. saw Chin Back. at 6 luffed too and shortened sail. Latter part fresh trades. Steering to S.W. Lat 4-41 Long 112

Sunday June 10th

First part fresh trades. at 6 P.M. luffed to the wind and shortened sail. Latter part pleasant trades. Steering S.W.

Monday June 11th

First part pleasant trades. Steering S.W. Latter part fine Employed Breaking out. Lat 4-47

Tuesday June 12th

First part fine saw Chin Backs at 6 P.M. shortened sail. Latter part fresh trades. Saw Chin Backs 112 20

Friday June 15th

First part Pleasant trades. Steering to S.W. saw one Chin Back. at 6 P.M. shortened sail. Latter part fresh trades. Steering to. Saw Porpoises. Lat 4-36 114-32

Saturday June 16th

First part fresh trades. Steering S.W. by 10. at 6 P.M. luffed too and shortened sail. Latter part strong trades. Steering by the wind to the southward. Saw nothing. Lat 2-09 Long 114-02

Sunday June 17th

First part strong trades. W. Steering by the wind to the southward. Towards the off shore ground. Latter part pleasant trades. On the off shore again. Lat 1-12 Long 115-14

Monday June 18th

First part pleasant trades. Saw Porpoises Latter part fine. Saw nothing. Long 115-37

Tuesday June 19th

First part fine saw Sped. Latter part fresh trades. Saw Porpoises Long 115-32

Wednesday June 20th

First part strong trades. at 2 P.M. took in top gallant sails, at 6 luffed ship to the S.W. Latter part saw nothing. Lat 4-01 Long
