Monday October 22th 1855

First part fresh breezes from the S & steering by the
wind to the S.W. at 8 P.M. commenced boiling.
Latter part strong winds. Employed boiling.

Tuesday October 23th

First part strong winds from the S & steering by
the wind to the S.W. at 5 P.M. tacked to the
S & E. under Double Reef's, jibs and spanker furled.
at 11:30 A.M. finished boiling the blubber and put on
the bean. Lat 2-26

Wednesday October 24th

First part fresh breezes from the S & steering
by the wind to the E & S. Latter part strong winds

Thursday November 1st 1855

First part strong winds from the S & steering
by the wind to the Eastward. at 6 P.M. tacked
to the S.W. under Double Reef's, Latter part more
moderate. Lat 2-55

Friday Nov 2nd

First part fresh breezes from the S & steering
by the wind to the S.W. at 6 P.M. tacked
to the Eastward. Latter part Employed storing oil.
Lat 2-40 Long 105-30

Saturday Nov 3rd

First part fresh breezes and squally. Employed
storing down. at 4:30 finished. at 15 Raised Sperm
whales and hove in. But it was too late to get to
them. Latter part fine Lat 2-30 Long 105-00

Sunday Nov 4th

First part Pleasant breezes from the S & steering
by the wind to the Eastward. Latter part fine
Lat 2-17 Long

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Monday November 5th 1855

First part Pleasant breezes from the Southward steering
by the wind to the Eastward. at 4:30 P.M. saw whales
going to the windward. at 5:15 lowered the S Boat
Struck, at 7:15 took him along side. at 7:40 commenced
cutting. at 9:15 finished Lat 2-40 Long 105-40
S.B. 25-1

Tuesday Nov 6th

First part strong breezes from the S & steering
by the wind to the Eastward. at 5:30 commenced boiling
at 4 Double Reefed. at 6 tacked ship to the S.W.
Latter part Pleasant breezes. at 8:30 finished boiling the
blubber and put on the bean. the whale turned up 30 fms.
Lat Long 105-50

Wednesday Nov 7th

First part fresh breezes from the Southward steering
by the wind to the Eastward. at 6 P.M. shortened sail.
Latter part pleasant breezes Lat 2-26 Long

Thursday Nov 8th

First part pleasant breezes from the Southward
steering by the wind to the Eastward. at 5:30 P.M.
raised whales at 5:30 lowered the boats the S Boat
Struck and I lowered the bean. at 6:15 returned to
the ship. Latter part light air. at 6 A.M. put her 80
saw breeches. at 12 luffed to the Eastward
Lat 2-13 Long 105-20

Friday Nov 9th

First part pleasant breezes from the Southward steering
by the wind to the Eastward. saw Porpoises. Latter
part fine saw Porpoises.

Saturday Nov 10th

First part fresh breezes from the S & steering by the
wind to the S.W. at 6 P.M. tacked to the Eastward and
shortened sail. Latter part strong winds. saw
Blin & Backs. Lat 2-36
