

Ship Napoleon Pacific Ocean, James A. Crowell Master.

Sunday November 11th 1855

First part Strong winds from the Southward steering by the wind to the Eastward. at 6 P.M. Double reefed the Main sails. Latter part fine. at 11 A.M. raised Whales. at 11 1/2 lowered the Boat. So ended the Boats Chasing. Lat 3-10 Long 104-20

Monday Nov 12th

First part fine. The Boats Chasing at 10 1/2 the L Boat Struck. at 1 the S.B. Struck. at 2 the W Boat Struck. the L Boat wafered her whale and struck another and drewed the Iron. at 5 P.M. took three to the Ship and prepared for cutting. at 5 1/2 A.M. commenced cutting. S.B. 40 W.B. 25



Tuesday Nov 13th

First part fresh trade. at 1 P.M. finished cutting at 6 finished clearing away the skins. at 8 started the fire. Latter part Employed Boiling and cutting Blubber.

Wednesday Nov 14th

First part fresh Bruges Bruges Employed Boiling Latter part fresh winds Lat 3-58 Long 104-30

Thursday Nov 15th

First part Strong Bruges. at 2 P.M. finished Boiling the Blubber and put on the lean. the whales turned up 14 Bolls. Latter part moderate. steering by the wind to the Eastward. Lat 3-10

Friday Nov 16th

First part Pleasant Bruges and fine steering by the wind to the Eastward. at 6 P.M. tackied to the Eastward. Latter part fine Employed Steaming Oil Lat 4-30

Saturday Nov 17th



First part Pleasant. at 6 P.M. finished Steaming 100 Bolls and packed Ship to the S.E. Latter fine at 1 1/2 A.M. raised a home whale going quick to the windward at 10 1/2 lowered the Boat but could not overhault him.

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Sunday November 18th 1855

First part Pleasant Bruges from the Southward steering by the wind to the S.E. Latter part light Bruges and squally. at 5 P.M. tackied to the S.W.

Monday Nov 19th

First part moderate Bruges and squally. Latter part fine saw nothing O dear I shot rather at my wife and child than anything else. Lat 3-41

Tuesday Nov 20th

Begins with pleasant Bruges from the Southward steering by the wind to the S.W. at 6 P.M. tackied to the Eastward and shortened sail. Saw Porpoises. Lat 3-40

Wednesday Nov 21st

Begins with light Bruges and thick weather. Latter part Employed starting water. O dear I am home sick Lat 3-40 Long 102-30

Thursday Nov 22nd

Begins with light and baffling Bruges from the Southward. Latter part squally. Lat 3-26 Long 101-17

Friday Nov 23rd

Begins with fresh Bruges and squally from the Southward steering by the wind to the Eastward. at 6 P.M. tackied the S.W. Latter part Strong Bruges. Lat 2-28 Long 100-20

Saturday Nov 24th

First part Strong Bruges from the S.E. steering by the wind to the S.W. Lat 1-24 Long 98-40

Sunday Nov 25th

First part Strong Bruges from the S.E. steering by the wind to the S.W. Latter part fine Lat 10-11
