Sunday December 9th 1855

First part pleasant Breezes from the S.E. steering  
by the wind to the S.W. at 6 P.M. tacked to the S.E. & C.  
 Latter part fine saw porpoises. Lat 4-22

Monday Dec 10th

First part pleasant Breezes from the S.E. steering  
by the wind to the E.S.E. latter part fine, saw  
two Barks one of them was the *Cornelia* of A. Reed.  
cutting a whale. Lat 4-25 Long 106-40

Tuesday Dec 11th

First part pleasant Breezes from the S.E. steering  
by the wind to the S.W. at 6 P.M. tacked to the N.E.  
 at 11 P.M. passed a ship. Lat 4-32

Wednesday Dec 12th

First part pleasant Breezes from the S.E. steering  
by the wind to the E.S.E. at 6 P.M. shortened sail  
 Latter part fine. at 3 A.M. tacked to the S.W.  
 saw nothing of note. Lat 4-35 Long 105-57

Thursday Dec 13th

First part fresh Breezes from the S.E. steering by  
the wind to the S.W. at 6 P.M. tacked to the E.S.E.  
 and shortened sail. Latter part fine. Lat 4-35 Long 104-

Friday Dec 14th

First part pleasant Breezes from the S.E.  
 steering by the wind to the E.S.E. employed repairing  
 fore sail. saw a sail. a bar if I could see my  
 wife and boy to night. Latter part fine. Lat 4-37 Long 103-30

Saturday Dec 15th

First part pleasant Breezes from the S.E.  
 steering by the wind to the S.W. at 5 P.M.  
 spoke the *Henry Wilcox* Capt Luce 170 tons 750  
 Latter part fresh Breezes. Lat 5-03

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Sunday Dec 16th 1855

First part fresh Breezes from the E.S.E. steering  
 by the wind to the S.W. at 3 1/2 P.M. raised a Gene  
 Topmast going quick to the N.E. we did not lower for  
 him there being no chance. Latter part strong Breezes  
 at 1 A.M. passed a sail sailing. Lat 5-34



Monday Dec 17th

First part strong Breezes and squalls steering by  
 the wind to the S.W. at 6 P.M. tacked to the E.S.E.  
 and shortened sail. Latter part strong Breezes, at  
 8 A.M. sent down the main sail to repair. saw 2  
 Pin Barks and one sail. Long 102-57

Tuesday Dec 18th

First part strong Breezes from the S.E. steering by the  
 wind to the E.S.E. employed repairing the main sail.  
 at 6 P.M. bent it. Latter part fresh Breezes saw  
 Porpoises and Pin Barks. Lat 5-49

Wednesday Dec 19th

First part fresh Breezes from the S.E. steering by the  
 wind to the S.W. at 5 P.M. spoke the splinter  
 of the *Down* 14 months old whale 30 sperm. Latter  
 part fine employed starting water. Lat Long 102-02

Thursday Dec 20th

First part pleasant Breezes from the S.E. steering  
 by the wind to the E.S.E. Latter part fine, at  
 12 A.M. tacked to the S.W. Lat 5-09

Friday Dec 21st

First part pleasant Breezes from the S.E.  
 steering by the wind to the S.W. at 6 P.M. shortened  
 sail. Latter part fine saw Porpoises. Lat 5-31
