Begins with light breezes from the Eastward  
steering by the wind to the Southward. Latter part

Lat 29-01 Long 115-18

Thursday Jan 17th

Begins with pleasant breezes from the E.S.E.  
steering by the wind to the Southward. Saw Gumpers.  
Saw one bear out to sea. I was one year  
ago with a bear and one around me. Latter part  
fine

Lat 31-00 Long 115-53

Friday Jan 18th

Begins with light breezes from the Eastward.  
steering by the wind to the Southward.  
Latter part fine.

Lat 32-21

Saturday Jan 19th

Begins with light breezes from the S.E. steering  
by the wind to the Southward. Latter part fine  
saw Gumpers.

33-14 115-31

Sunday Jan 20th

Begins with light sails from the S.E. steering by the  
wind to the N.E. at 2 to 3 to the Southward  
Latter part pleasant breezes from the N.W. to course  
East. Saw Gumpers

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Monday Jan 21st 1856

Begins with light breezes from the N.W. course  
to S. Latter part fine

Lat 33-25 Long 115-12

Tuesday Jan 22nd

Begins with pleasant breezes from the N.W. course E  
by S. Ends with pleasant breezes

Lat 35-53 Long 111-50

Wednesday Jan 23rd

Begins with moderate breezes and squalls from  
the N.W. to course E by S. Latter part fine  
Employed painting the brass work and mizzen top  
and shrouts.

Lat 34-00 Long 98-40

Thursday Jan 24th

Pleasant breezes from the N.W. to course E by S.  
Latter part fresh breezes saw Porpoises and Guine.

Lat 34-20 Long 85-38

Friday Jan 25th

First part fresh breezes from the N.W. course  
E by S. at 7 P.M. the wind hauled to the  
Westward in a small course E by S. Saw  
two fish. Latter part wind to the Southward

Lat 34-15 Long 92-40

Saturday Jan 26th

First part light breezes from the Eastward.  
steering by the wind to the N.E. Latter part  
light sails at 1 A.M. tacked to the S.E. saw  
Gumpers.

Lat 33-26 Long 92-08

Sunday Jan 27th

First part light breezes from the N.W. course  
E by S. Latter part light breezes from the W.S.W. saw  
a sail steering to the Eastward.

Lat 33-32 Long 91-46

Monday Jan 28th

First part light breezes from the W.S.W. at 6 P.M. hauled  
to the Southward. Latter part strong breezes from the  
E.S.E. saw a Brig steering to the Southward
