Saturday Feb 23rd 1856

Begins with strong winds from the S E steering
for the to the S W. at 6 1/2 reefed the top sails.
at 1 A.M. parted the chain Bree Star. at 2 took in
the Main sail, at 6 1/2 fished and let the Bree Star
up. at 8 1/2 took in the Gibb and Spanker.

Lat 19-44 Long 83-21

Sunday Feb 24th

Begins with strong winds from the E S E steering
for the wind to the Southward under Double reefed
top sails, fished and Spanker & and main sail furled.
at 1 1/2 Close reefed the Bree and Mizzen top sails.
at 10 1/2 furled the Bree sail. Latter part more
moderate made some sail. Lat 20-57 Long 84-18

Monday Feb 25th

Begins with strong breezes from the S E steering
for the wind to the S W under single reefed
top sails. Latter part quite fine
Lat 22-42 Long 85-45

Tuesday Feb 26th

Begins with pleasant breezes from the S E steering
for the wind to the Southward all sail set.
Latter part fine. Employed shortening the Bree
Star and setting it up again. Lat 24-29 Long 87-15

Wednesday Feb 27th

Begins with pleasant breezes from the S E
steering by the wind to the Southward.
Lat 26-44 Long 89-46

Thursday Feb 28th

Begins with light airs from the Eastward. Employed
letting up rigging. Lat 26-26 Long 88-40

Friday Feb 29th

Begins with light breezes from the Southward steering by the
wind to the E S E. Employed letting up the head stay

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Saturday March 1st 1856

Begins with light airs from the N E course S E
at 6 P.M. the wind hauled to the Southward,
saw a sail. Latter part pleasant breezes from the
Eastward steering by the wind to the S E
Lat 28-03 Long 88-46

Sunday March 2nd

Begins with pleasant breezes from the Eastward steering
by the wind to the S E two jumps. Latter
part fresh breezes from the N E and squally.
course S E.

Monday March 3rd

Begins with strong breezes from the N E by E
course S E. Latter part moderate breezes
Employed repairing the Bree Mast Star sail.
Lat 31-31 Long 86-58

Tuesday March 4th

Begins with moderate breezes from the S E steering
for the wind to the Southward. Latter part calm.
Tent down the Bree sail and repaired, and bent it
again. Lat 32-45 Long 87-15

Wednesday March 5th

Begins with light airs and calm. Latter part light breezes
from the S E course S E by S. we got a Porpoise which
made us a fine fresh mess. we took a young one out of her
4 inches long which the Capt put in alcohol to preserve it.

Thursday March 6th

Begins with light breezes from the S E steering
for the wind to the Eastward. Latter part pleasant
breezes from the S E course S E by E.
