Saturday March 28th 1856
Fine weather wind from the North East. Employed
Stowing the Holes.

Sunday March 29th
Fine weather wind from the South East. One watch ashore
on liberty.

Monday March 31st
First part fine. Employed setting up shacks
for salt water. Stowed 2 and fitted them. Discharged
George Smith. Watch ashore on liberty.

Tuesday March April 1st
Fine weather. Employed variously in ship. Duty.
The watch on shore on liberty.

Wednesday April 2nd
Fine weather. Wind from the South East. All hands
on board.

Thursday April 3rd
Fine weather wind from the South East. Employed
getting water. 3 men Deserted.

Friday April 4th
Fine weather wind from the South East. Employed
getting water. At noon finished.

Saturday April 5th
Fine weather wind from the South East.
Employed Stowing off the Holes and getting ready
for sea.

Since April 6th
Fine weather wind from the South East. at 10^{1/2}
A M took our anchor and went to sea.

Sunday April 7th
Fine weather. Employed Stowing Chains
and Anchors. at 6 P M set the watches.

Tuesday April 8th 1856
Begins with light breezes from the South East.
Course to be S. E. Saw 3 or 4 Ducks.

Wednesday April 9th Lat 34-00
Begins with light breezes from the South East.
Course to be S. E. Latter part light air. at 6 A M
raised the Island of Juan Fernandez bearing S. by E. 25
miles. Saw a brig.

Thursday April 10th
Begins with light air and calms. at 6 P M the Island
bearing S by E 25 miles. Latter part light wind
from the N. W. and squally. Employed resalting & Reef.

Friday April 11th
Begins with light breezes from the N. W. Steering
by the wind to the N. E. Employed resalting
& Reef. Latter part light breezes and fine.

Saturday April 12th
Begins with light breezes from the S. W. and fine.
Course N. E. Employed washing ship.
Latter part fine breezes from the South East.

Sunday April 13th Lat 29-28 Long 75-25
Begins with pleasant breezes from the South East
Course N. E. Latter part fresh breezes.

Monday April 14th Lat 28-40 Long 74-01
First part fresh breezes from the South East
and fine. Latter part strong winds and cloudy.

Tuesday April 15th Lat 25-35 Long 72
First part strong winds from the South East
at 2 P M saw the land S. by E 50 miles. at
6 shortened sail and steered N. Latter the same
saw a sail.
