Wednesday June 4th 1856

First part Pleasant breezes from the S.E. steering by the wind to the S.W. Latter part fine, the wind E.S.E. saw Pin Backs. Lat 4-13 Long 102-45

Thursday June 5th 1856

First part pleasant breezes from the S.E. steering by the wind to the Southward. saw Pin Backs 4 at 6 P.M. shorted sail. On the off shore breeze. Latter part strong breezes.

Lat 5-25 Long 103-30

Friday June 6th

First part strong breezes from the S.E. steering by the wind to the Southward. at 6 P.M. lashed to the N.E. Latter part strong breezes steering by the wind to the N.E. hence South West.

Lat 5-18 Long

Saturday June 7th

First part strong breezes from the S.E. steering by the wind to the N.E. hence South West. Main sail furled. Latter part strong breezes.

Lat 5-12 Long 103-30

Sunday June 8th

First part strong breezes steering by the wind to the Southward. at 1 1/2 P.M. spoke the Ship Robert Edwards. Capt. Kelly. Latter part more moderate. Lat 5-06 Long 103-22

Monday June 9th

First part strong breezes steering by the wind to the Southward. at 3 P.M. saw 10 Whales and lowered the Boat. the L. Boat struck and took one to the ship. once killed another with a bomb lance but lost it by the BB Boats getting stove. at 6 A.M. commenced cutting, at 2 1/2 finished.

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Wednesday June 10th 1856

Strong breezes. Lat 1 1/2 commenced Boiling Latter part more moderate. at 3 A.M. finished Boiling. the whale turned up 4 BBs. saw 80 fish.

Lat 4-57 Long 103-32

Thursday June 11th

First part moderate breezes steering by the wind to the S.E. saw Pin Backs. Latter part light breezes. Lat 5-00 Long 103-30

Friday June 12th

First part light breezes from the S.E. steering by the wind to the Southward. Latter part strong breezes. at 6 A.M. lashed ship to the S.E. saw Pin Backs. Lat 5-15 Long 103-20

Saturday June 13th

First part strong breezes from the S.E. steering by the wind to the S.E. saw 80 fish. Latter part light breezes. Lat 4-54 Long 102-36

Sunday June 14th

First part light breezes steering by the wind to the S.E. at 6 P.M. lashed to the Southward. Latter part fine. saw Porpoises. Lat 5-16 Long 102-48

Monday June 15th

First part light breezes steering by the wind to the S.W. at 6 P.M. lashed to the S.E. Latter part fine. Lat 5-25 Long 102-25

Tuesday June 16th

First part pleasant breezes. Course N.E. saw Pin Backs. at 6 P.M. lashed to the wind. Latter part fine saw 8 ship.
