

Ship Napoleon Pacific Ocean, James A. Brownell Master.

Thursday Aug 28th 1856

First part strong breezes from the southward, steering by the wind heading E by S. Latter part strong breezes. Employed repairing the main top. Sailed. Lat 5-05 Long 1

Friday Aug 29th

First part fresh breezes from the southward, steering by the wind to the E by S. Latter part moderate breezes and cloudy. No Lat.

Saturday Aug 30th

First part moderate breezes from the southward, steering by the wind heading E by S. Latter part moderate, saw a Pin Back.

Lat 4-04 Long 98-22

Sunday Aug 31st

First part moderate breezes from the southward, steering by the wind heading E by S. Latter part fine. Lat 3-33 Long 96-52

Monday Sept 1st 1856

First part fresh breezes from the southward steering by the wind heading E by S. Latter part fine breezes. Broke out Whop. Lat 3-07 Long 95-16

Tuesday Sept 2nd

First part pleasant breezes from the southward steering by the wind heading E by S. Went another bare whop. Latter part fine

Lat 2-42 Long 93-55

Wednesday Sept 3rd

First part fine breezes from the southward steering by the wind heading E by S. Caught a Porpoise. Latter part fresh breezes. at 10 1/2 saw Outpoppers. Head bearing E by S Dist 40 miles.

at noon Lat 1-59 Long

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Thursday Sept 4th 1856

First part fresh breezes from the southward, steering by the wind heading E by S. at 5 1/2 P.M. the Capt went a fishing but it was too late to catch any. Latter part fine, at 8 1/2 A.M. saw whales and hovered. When and distance bearing by Dist 35 miles. at noon the S Boat struck, a loose whale got the line in his mouth and drew the line. So ended Boats Chasin. the L Boat struck.

Friday Sept 5th

First part fresh breezes from the southward. Boats Chasing whales. at 2 1/2 P.M. the L B took her whale to the ship, at 4 the L and B Boats struck. the whales got entangled in the line and parted from the B B Boats whale and he went off spouting blood. at 5 1/2 took the L B Boats whale to the ship. at 5 1/2 A.M. commenced getting at 10 finished. turned up 30 B B B

Saturday Sept 6th

Fresh breezes and squally. at 3 P.M. commenced Boiling. Latter part strong breezes Employed at Boiling, at noon finished. Lat 1-45 Long 91-06

Sunday Sept 7th

First part strong breezes steering by the wind to the Eastward very squally. Latter part the same

Lat 1-52 Long 90-00

Monday Sept 8th

First part fresh breezes from the southward steering by the wind heading E by S. Latter part squally.

Lat 1-34 Long 88-16
