it down.

Fine weather variously Employed in ship's duty.

Fine weather Employed painting and
taring down

Sunday Sept 28th

I have been employed reading and writing
Letters.

Monday Sept 29th

Fine weather at 4 P.M. the Captain came
on board, ready for sea.

Tuesday Sept 30th

Fine wind from the westward. At 6 A.M.
took our Anchor and stood out to sea.
At 10^{1/2} finished stowing the Anchors.
And I hope we shall get a good cruise, for
we did not sail Sunday this time.
I hope God will prosper us in our under-
takings this cruise. Although unworthy.

Wednesday Oct 1st 1856

First part pleasant breezes from the
westward. at 5^{1/2} had a public band of
of bags and dirt. the property of the
Legation. Latter part fresh breezes, steering
by the wind to the westward. Saw two ships.
One man sick forward. I hope we shall
not get the small pox. As it is a
deadly disease on ship board.

First part fresh breezes from the S.W. steering
by the wind to the westward the Captain took
the S.D. Boat stowed to stow him and put
George Bahita in to stow the S.D. Boat.

Friday Oct 3rd

First part fresh breezes from the S.E. steering
by the wind heading S.W. Employed repairing
the Spanker. Saw S.D. Boat. Latter part fine
and Bump & Backs Lat 3-19 Long 87-00

Saturday Oct 4th

First part fine breezes from the S.E. course to by S.
Latter part fine. Saw a Bark. Supposed to be the Richmond.
Saw S.D. Boat backing. Lat 3-20

Sunday Oct 5th

First part pleasant breezes from the S.E. course to by S.
Latter part fine. Mr Rogers sick with a fever.
Lat 3-23 Long 91-26

Monday Oct 6th

First pleasant breezes from the S.E. course to by S. Saw S.D.
Boat. Latter part fine. Mr Rogers has the inflammatory fever.
Lat 3-20 Long 94-10

Tuesday Oct 7th

First part fine breezes from the S.E. course to by S.
Employed painting the S.D. Boat and one over head.
Latter part fine. Saw Porpoises and S.D. Boats.
the watch employed repairing sails. Mr Rogers rather
more comfortable.

Wednesday Oct 8th

First part pleasant breezes from the S.E. course
to by S. Saw a plenty of S. White W. Birds.
Latter part fresh breezes, saw S.D. Boats.
