Sunday Oct 19th 1856

First part light Breezes from the S E Course
N by E. Saw Grampuses. At 6 P.M. suffered too heart-
ily E N E. Latter part light air from the E N E.
Course to S.W. My Stomach is rather better. but
I fear there is the seed of some disease lurking there,
that will cause me trouble at some future day. and
perhaps shorten my voyage. But I hope for the best.
I hope the Lord will spare my health for the sake of
those dependant on me. Lat 10-07 Long 104-46

Monday Oct 20th

First part light airs from the Eastward, Course
S.W. Saw Black fish. Latter part pleasant
Breezes. Saw Squire. Lat 10-11 Long 105-16

Tuesday Oct 21st

First part pleasant Breezes from the
S E heading S.W. With and latter parts light
airs and calm. Saw Grampuses and Squire.
Lat 10-23 Long 105-36

Wednesday Oct 22nd

First part light Breezes from the S E heading
S.W. by the wind. Emphysis watching down
the main top mast rigging. My Brest
has been rather better all day. With and
latter part calm and foggy. Lat 10-53 Long 106-45

Thursday Oct 23rd

First part light airs from the S E with thick
muggy weather. heading S.W. Saw Sulphur
Bottoms. With part calm. Latter part light
Breezes and foggy. Lat 1-31 Long 107-41

My Brest has been some painful to day. I know
not what is it. it may be the Rheumatism.

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Friday Oct 24th 1856

First part light Breezes heading S by W. by the
wind. Saw Porpoises. With part calm. Latter
part light Breezes. Saw One Sulphur Bottom.
Lat 2-19 Long 108-16

Saturday Oct 25th

First part light Breezes from the E S E heading
S by the wind. Saw Porpoises. Latter part
fine. Saw One Cow Bin Back. Lat 4-08 Long 108-37

Sunday Oct 26th

First part fresh Breezes from the Eastward
steering by the wind to the Southward. at 6 P.M.
shortened sail. Latter part strong Breezes.
My Stomach has been rather painful. Lat 5-31 Long 109-20

Monday Oct 27th

First part strong Breezes from the E S E.
heading by the wind to the Southward. at 6 P.M.
took her to the N E. Latter part fresh Breezes.
Saw Porpoises. started water. Lat 5-01 Long 108-05

Tuesday Oct 28th

First part strong Breezes from the E S E.
heading N E. by the wind. Saw One Bin Back.
latter part fresh Breezes. Saw Squire Porpoises Bin
Backs and a Sail. Lat 4-37 Long 109-11

Wednesday Oct 29th

First part strong Breezes from the E S E
heading by the wind to the Southward. Saw
Porpoises. Latter part strong winds heading
N E under double reef. Saw One Bin
Back. Signalled the Annet Gibbs of
Fair Haven. Lat 4-46 Long 109-40
