Wednesday Nov 11th 1856

First part strong breezes from the E. S. E. heading by the wind to the Southward. Latter part fine. at 1 A. M. tacked to the N. E.

Thursday Nov 12th

First part pleasant breezes from the Eastward heading N. E. by N. by the wind. at 6 P. M. tacked to the Southward. Latter part fresh breezes. at 5 P. M. tacked to the N. E. and commenced stowing down Oil.

Lat 4-43 Long

Friday Nov 13th

First part fresh breezes from the Eastward heading N. E. by N. by the wind. at 5 P. M. finished stowing down and washed off the whole stowage 23 bbls. at 6 tacked to the Southward. Latter part pleasant breezes.

Lat 5-10 Long 113-29

Saturday Nov 14th

First part pleasant breezes from the E. S. E. heading S. by the wind. at 6 P. M. tacked to the N. E. Latter part fine heading to the N. E.

Lat 4-42 Long 112-57

Sunday Nov 15th

First part pleasant breezes from the E. S. E. heading N. E. by the wind. Latter part fine. Saw Squid and Porpoises. at 1 A. M. tacked to the Southward.

Lat 4-38 Long 112-41

Monday Nov 16th

Begins with fresh breezes from the Eastward heading by the wind S. E. Saw Porpoises and a Seal. Latter part fine heading S. E. by S. at noon tacked to the Northward.

Lat 6-07 Long 112-46

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Monday Nov 17th 1856

Begins with fresh breezes from the Eastward heading N. by E. by the wind. Latter part fine saw a Seal stowing to the Westward. 22 bbls. tacked out to sea. My little dog is 17 months old if living. Oh I should like to see him with my other dear friends. I could kick the main A that mistook his miniature.

Tuesday Nov 18th

First part pleasant breezes from the Eastward heading N. N. E. by the wind. at 6 P. M. tacked to the S. E. Latter part fine. saw a Bark. Lat 5-17 Long 112-26

Wednesday Nov 19th

Begins with pleasant breezes from the Eastward heading S. E. at 6 P. M. tacked to the N. N. E. Latter part fine. saw a Bark.

Lat 5-15 Long 112-16

Thursday Nov 20th

First part fine breezes from the E. S. E. heading N. E. the Bark still in sight. Latter part fine saw Squid.

Lat 5-26 Long 112-30

Friday Nov 21st

Begins with pleasant breezes from the E. S. E. heading S. spoke the Bark B. Cummings. Latter part fine heading to the N. N. E. the Bark and a ship in sight.

Lat 5-11 Long

Saturday Nov 22nd

Begins with pleasant breezes from the Eastward heading to the N. N. E. the Bark B. Cummings and a ship in sight. Latter part fresh breezes at 5 A. M. tacked to the S. E. the ship Philip Delanoze in sight. Lat 5-07 Long 112-00
