Begins with fresh Breezes from the S.E., heading S.W., saw Chin. Boats, at 6 P.M. tacked to the N.E. Latter part fresh Breezes, parted the Red jib stay and spruce it, repaired and set the sail. Lat 5-01 Long 113-00

Friday Dec 5th

Begins with fresh Breezes from the E.S.E. heading N.E. saw Squid. Latter part strong winds at 5 P.M. tacked to the Southward. Lat 9 Single reefed the Main sails. Lat 4-57 Long 112-48

Saturday Dec 6th

Begins with strong winds from the E.S.E. heading to the Southward. At 6 P.M. tacked to the N.E. Latter part little more moderate. Lat 4-47 Long 112-55

Sunday Dec 7th

Begins with fresh Breezes from the E.S.E. heading N.E. Latter part pleasant Breezes, at 5 P.M. tacked to the Southward. Saw two Sails. Lat 4-30 Long 112-57

Monday Dec 8th

Begins with pleasant Breezes from S.E., heading S.W., at 6 P.M. tacked to the N.E. saw Black Fish. Latter part fresh Breezes. Saw Porpoises. Lat 4-11 Long 112-43

Tuesday Dec 9th

Begins with fresh Breezes from the S.E. heading N.E. by E. Latter part pleasant Breezes, at 1 P.M. tacked to the Southward. saw 8 B. fish. Lat 4-20 Long 112-27

Wednesday Dec 10th

Begins with pleasant Breezes from the E.S.E., heading S. Latter part fine. at 1 P.M. tacked to the N.E. Lat 4-46 Long 112-57

Begins with pleasant Breezes from the S.E., heading N.E. by E. saw a Sail, at 3 P.M. tacked to the Southward. Latter part fresh Breezes, Lat 4-57 Long 113-42

Friday Dec 12th

Begins with fresh Breezes from the E.S.E., heading to the Southward. at 6 P.M. tacked to the N.E. Latter part fine. Lat 4-23 Long 112-48

Saturday Dec 13th

Begins with pleasant Breezes from the Eastward heading N.E. saw cow fish. at 6 P.M. tacked to the Southward. Latter part moderate strong westerly current. Lat 5-11 Long 113-32

Sunday Dec 14th

Begins with pleasant Breezes from the S.E., heading S.W., at 1 P.M. tacked to the E.N.E. Latter part fine. Lat 4-24 Long 113-10

Monday Dec 15th

Begins with pleasant Breezes from the S.E., heading E.N.E. Latter part fresh Breezes, at 1 P.M. tacked to the Southward. Lat 4-28 Long 112-35

Tuesday Dec 16th

Begins with fresh Breezes from the Eastward and squally. heading S.E., saw the ship, R. Edwards, one Chin. Boat and a piece of Squid. Latter part fresh Breezes, at 1 P.M. tacked to the N.E. Employed setting up the Mizzen Rigging. Lat 4-36 Long 112-55
