

Ship Napoleon Pacific Ocean, James A. Crowell Master.

Sunday January 25th 1857

Begins with fresh Breezes from the S.E., heading by the wind to the Eastward. Saw Bird Backs at 6 P.M. wore ship the Island of Juan bearing S.E. Dist 6 miles. at 4 1/2 P.M. wore ship and ran under the lee of the Island. Saw Frampuses. Barometer 29 7/10. At noon the land bearing S.E. by S Dist 10 miles. Lat 33-28

Monday Jan 26th

Begins with fresh Breezes from the S.E., heading to the Eastward. at 6 P.M. the wind hauled more to the Southward, at 7 took in sail. the Island bearing S.W. by W Dist 25 miles. Barometer 29 7/10. Latter part moderate. 33-33

Tuesday Jan 27th

Begins with strong Breezes from the S.E., heading S.W. Land bearing S.W. at 4 1/2 P.M. the Capt. went on shore. at 6 1/2 returned to the ship, brought off some Chirps from the Isle of Robinson Crusoe. Latter part strong winds. saw two sails. Land bearing S.E. Dist 12 miles. Barometer 30 7/10

Wednesday Jan 28th

Begins with strong winds from S.E. by E heading S. Spoke ships Florida and May. A Brazil of N.B. bound to the Sandwich Islands. Latter part strong winds. at noon Massafuera in sight bearing W Dist 40 miles. Barometer 30 Lat 33-51

Thursday Jan 29

Begins strong winds from the S.E. heading S.W. Under South's Reef Ship sails fift and Spanker. at 6 1/2 wore ship to the Eastward Massafuera bearing N.W. Dist 35 miles. Latter part more moderate. at noon Juan bearing N.E. by E Dist 35 miles. Barometer 30 Lat 33-58

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Friday Jan 30th 1857

Begins with strong Breezes from the S.E., heading by the wind to the Eastward, at 7 P.M. Juan bearing N.W. by E Dist 15 miles. Latter part strong winds. at noon Juan bearing N.W. by W Dist 10 miles. Lat 34-13 Barometer 30

Saturday Jan 31st 1857

Begins with strong Breezes from the Southward heading E.S.E. by the wind. Latter part more moderate, set whole Ship sails the first time for five days. Lat 34-43 Long

Sunday February

Begins with moderate Breezes from the S.W., heading by the wind S.E. under easy sails. Middle part moderate Breezes from the N.W. at 2 A.M. hauled in a Squal to the Southward again. Doubt Kiped fished and main sail. the weather very changeable. Lat 35-30 Long 76-02 Barometer 29 7/10 by Dist 76-14

Monday Feb 2^d

Begins with pleasant Breezes from the Southward heading by the wind to the E.S.E. at 3 P.M. hauled S.W. heads S.E. Latter part light Breezes from the Eastward. heading to the Southward. Saw Black fish and a ship.

Tuesday Feb 3^d

Begins with light Breezes from the Eastward. Saw three sails. at 5 however one caught a sun fish. Latter part fresh Breezes from the Northward. heading E.S.E. Lat 36-26 Long by Obs 78-53. but the distance and Juan give the Chronometer 45 miles to the Eastward of the ship's true position.
