

Ship Napoleon Pacific Ocean James A. Crowell Master.

Wednesday February 4th 1857
Rigins with strong S wind from the N. N. W.
Course E by N. N. E. for Palcahuano.
at 4 P. M. set in thick and raining. took in the
main sail, took a ship. Double Reefed, for the
city. at 6 the wind backed to the
N. W. by W. and increased. took in the fore and
mizen. (Clap sails, at 12 went to the Northward
which W. S. W. blowing heavy in the squalls and
a heavy S. W. swell. at 4 P. M. put her off East-
ward. made sail. at 8 A. M. raised S. M. masts
bearing E S E Dist 20 miles. at noon P. M. bearing
E by S Dist 20 miles. Course E N E.

Thursday Feb 5th
Rigins with light air from the N. S. W. and
a heavy S. W. swell. Steering E N E for Palcahuano.
at 6 P. M. bent the chains and got the anchors
off the S. bow. Point Palcahuano bearing E Dist
10 miles. P. M. bearing S E by S Dist 15 miles
One sail in sight at 13 P. M. (civil time) came
to anchor same too Anchor in Palcahuano Bay
in 19 fathoms of water. at 9 1/2 got under way
and worked up to the anchorage. at 2 P. M. came
too in 5 fathoms of water.

Friday Feb 6th
Fine weather Employed cooping oil.

Saturday Feb 7th
Fine weather. Employed cooping oil. at
6 P. M. finished and stowed down 208 bbls.

Sunday Feb 8th
Fine weather Employed doing nothing. One
watch on liberty.

Fine weather Employed cooping meat.

Tuesday Feb 9th
Fresh & Breezes from the Northward and raining

Wednesday Feb 11th
Fine weather. Employed getting water.

Thursday Feb 12th
Fine weather. Employed getting water. I received
one letter to day. Among all those that profess friend-
ship for me there was one that does not forget
me. My dear sister I do not think hard of. for her
griefs are too great for her. I suppose she could not
write. O my own sister when will your cup of
afflictions be full. May God give you strength
to bear them.

hauling ship.
