Sunday April 26th 1857

Begins with light breezes from E. S. E.
Heading to the Southward. Saw squid.
Latter part fine. at 1 A.M. wore ship
to the N.E. Lat 5-19 Long 103-53

Monday April 27th

Begins with moderate breezes from the
E. S. E. heading to the N.E. Latter part light
breezes from the E. S. E. at 5 P.M. wore
ship to the Southward. Saw fish, birds and
porpoises. Lat 5-23 Long 103-37

Tuesday April 28th

Begins with light breezes from the E. S. E.
Heading by the wind to the Southward.
Latter part pleasant breezes. at 5 P.M. wore
ship to the N. N. E. Lat 5-00 Long 103-57

Wednesday April 29th

Begins with pleasant breezes from
the Eastward heading N. N. E. Latter part
pleasant breezes from the S. E. by E. at 2 P.M.
lacked to the Southward. Saw birds,
fish and porpoises. Lat 5-15 Long 104-04

Thursday April 30th

Begins with pleasant breezes from the
S. E. by E. heading by to the Southward. saw
one fish and bird. at 6 P.M. wore ship
to the N.E. Latter part fresh breezes.
Saw squid and porpoises.

Lat 4-56 Long 103-30

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Friday May 1st 1857

Begins with pleasant breezes from the Eastward heading
N. N. E. Saw squid. Latter part pleasant breezes.
Saw a ship. Lat 4-28 Long 103-23

Saturday May 2nd

Begins with pleasant breezes from the E. S. E. heading
to the Southward, at 3 P.M. spoke the ship Doctor Sayer
Chase 5 1/2 months out 120 bbls. Latter part squally
heading N.E. Saw a ship with painted parts.
Lat 4-00 Long 103-32

Sunday May 3rd

Begins with fresh breezes from E. S. E. heading N.E.
Latter part pleasant breezes from S.E. at 1 A.M. wore
ship to the N.E. Lat 4-39 Long 103-40

Monday May 4th

Begins with pleasant breezes from E. S. E. heading
to the Southward. Saw two ships. Latter part fine
at 2 A.M. wore ship to the N.E. Saw a sail.
Lat 4-54 Long 104-01

Tuesday May 5th

Begins with pleasant breezes from the S.E.
heading N.E. Latter part fine. at 1 A.M. wore ship
to the Southward. Lat 5-14 Long 104-03

Wednesday May 6th

Begins with pleasant breezes from the S.E. heading
by the wind to the Southward. Latter part fresh breezes
at 1 A.M. wore to the N.E. at 6 1/2. started off N. Saw one
fish and bird. Lat 5-18 Long 104-30

Thursday May 7th

Begins with pleasant breezes from the S.E. course N. at 4 P.M.
lacked to the wind. Saw one fish and bird. Latter part fine
at 5 A.M. wore ship to the Southward. Saw porpoises and
squid. Lat 4-52 Long 104-26
